Councilman Owen and Terra,

We visited the alley located in back of 1446 Cherokee Road today. There are several locations in which significant depressions/heaves within the roadway have occurred. Additionally, there are 2 large plates at 1446 within this alley. We have come up with approximately 500 square yards of repairs needed to help regrade the alley and replace the pavers as part of the repair work. At \$100 /SY we would be looking at approximately \$50,000.00 for just these limited repairs. Please note that there are several other areas that have been previously patched within this alley that this cost will not cover. we are proposing we fix the areas where motoring vehicles may be scraping their undercarriage with the brick pavers. If you do want to proceed with this project we will also reach out to MSD to see if they will help with the manholes.

I have attached 2 pictures of the alley for your review. I also have additional photos if you would like to see more, but the file sizes are rather large so I do not want to overload your inbox.
