After some discussion we have formulated a design for constructing protection for the tree wells along Edith Rd at Champions Soccer Park.

The cost for constructing protection is \$1723.00. There may some unexpected expenses but the attached quote should cover the bulk of the materials.

The design will box in the tree wells on three side at a height of 2'. This design is attractive and will provide protection for the entire well. The design uses 4 6"x6" posts to support 3 2"x6" boards. This will box in the well on the road and parking lot sides. This prevents vehicles from driving into the tree well.

All the lumber is pressure treated. The posts are 'ground contact' pressure treated. Pressure treated lumber will make the well protection durable. The work will be performed by park's staff
