AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$4019,000 FROM ~~DISTRICT 5~~ NEIGHBORHOOD DEVELOPMENT FUNDS IN THE FOLLOWING MANNER: \$18,500 FROM DISTRICT 5; AND \$250 EACH FROM DISTRICTS 16 AND 17; THROUGH THE OFFICE OF MANAGEMENT AND BUDGET, TO PORTLAND MUSEUM, INC. FOR OPERATING EXPENSE, PROGRAM EXPENSES ASSOCIATED WITH PAPER, PRINTING & POETRY: BOOK ARTS BIND A COMMUNITY TO ITS FUTURE, AND CAPITAL EXPENDITURES. (AS AMENDED).

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE LOUISVILLE/JEFFERSON COUNTY METRO GOVERNMENT (THE COUNCIL) AS FOLLOWS:


SECTION I: The ~~amount~~ sum of \$4019,000 is hereby appropriated from ~~District 5~~ Neighborhood Development Funds in the following manner: \$18,500 from District 5; and \$250 each from Districts 16 and 17; through the Office of Management and Budget, to Portland Museum, Inc. for operating expenses, program expenses associated with Paper, Printing & Poetry: Book Arts Bind a Community to its Future, and capital expenditures.


SECTION II: The Council has determined the funds requested in this Ordinance will be expended for a public purpose.
