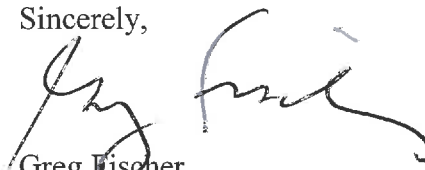

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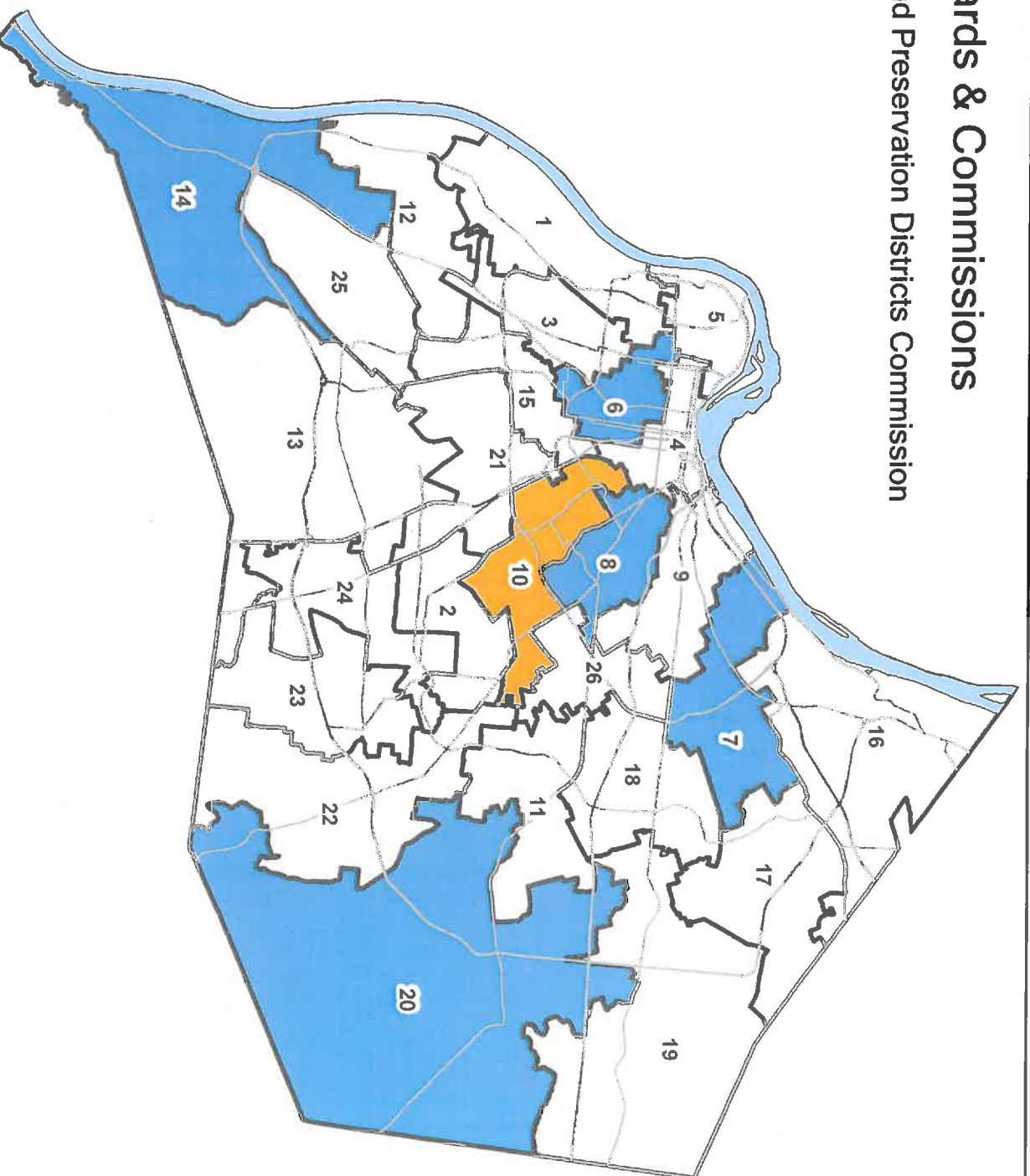

HOW APPOINTED	Mayor appoints 10 with approval of the Council
EX OFFICIO MEMBERS	Director of IPL Executive Director of Planning Commission Council member appointed by President of Council
QUALIFICATION OF MEMBERS	Mayoral appointees must include 1 architect, 1 architect or landscape architect, 1 historian or architectural historian qualified in the field of historic preservation, 1 registered professional archaeologist, 1 licensed real estate broker or MAI designated real estate appraiser, 1 attorney, 1 member of Metro Area Chamber of Commerce who has recognized experience in business. All must have a known interest in Local Landmarks and District Preservation.
COUNCIL APPROVAL OF APPOINTMENT	Yes
COMPENSATION	Members serve without compensation but shall be reimbursed for expenses necessarily incurred in the performance of their duties.
TERM OF APPOINTMENT	3 year term extending from December 1 st of one year for three years through and until November 30 th . Members serve until the appointment and qualification of the members' successor.
VACANCY APPOINTMENT	No language in ordinance on term of office for person appointed to fill a vacancy.
AUTOMATIC REAPPOINTMENT UNDER KRS 65.008(2)?	No
REMOVAL	Can be immediately removed if member misses 3 consecutive regular meetings without sufficient excuse.
POWERS	Commission shall have all necessary and implied powers to perform such duties in respect to the establishment, regulation, and promotion of historic landmarks, landmark sites and preservation districts.
BONDING AUTHORITY	No
RECORDS/ REPORTS	Keep minutes and records of all proceedings, including the number of votes for and against each question and the records of the vote of each member.

PURPOSE	Effect and accomplish the preservation, protection, perpetuation and use of historic landmarks, landmark sites, neighborhoods, areas, places, structures and improvements having a special or distinctive character or a special historic, aesthetic, architectural, archaeological, or cultural interest or value to the City; promote the educational, cultural, economic and general welfare of the people and safeguard the City's history and heritage as embodied and reflected in such landmarks, sites and districts; foster civic pride in the value of notable accomplishments of the past; enhance the visual and aesthetic character, diversity and interest of the City.

	real estate professional and 1 the owner of income producing property within the District. Members serve at pleasure of Commission. Quorum is 4 members. ECONOMIC REVIEW PANEL – established upon request for an economic hardship exemption. Composed of 3 persons with expertise in real estate and development who are knowledgeable in real estate economics in general. 1 selected by Commission, 1 person selected by applicant and 1 person from economic review panel pool. Economic review panel consists of no less than 3 or more than 12 peoples appointed by Mayor and approved by Council
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
