Subject: Formal Request for Public Records Pursuant to Nevada Revised Statutes Chapter 239 – Naughty List Inquiry

To Whom It May Concern:

Pursuant to the Nevada Public Records Act, codified under NRS Chapter 239 et seq., and in my official capacity as the duly appointed Chief Joy Officer and Supreme Arbiter of Naughty and Nice Conduct for the Greater North Pole Region and its subsidiaries, I, Santa Claus (a.k.a. Kris Kringle, Saint Nicholas, Father Christmas), do hereby submit this formal and legally binding request for access to public records maintained by the Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department (hereinafter “LVMPD”).

This request is made in furtherance of my annual due diligence obligations under the Global Gift-Giving Compliance Act (GGGCA) and the Elfin Oversight and Naughty Behavior Mitigation Directive (EONBMD), which require a comprehensive review of behavioral infractions, misdemeanors, and other naughtiness indicators for individuals domiciled within the jurisdictional boundaries of Las Vegas and Clark County.

Scope of Request:

I respectfully request access to the following public records, to the extent they are not exempt from disclosure under NRS 239.010 et seq.:

1. Incident Crime Reports (ICRs) and Arrest Reports (ARs) for individuals under the age of 18, from December 26, 2024, through May 25, 2025, for the purposes of evaluating eligibility for reclassification from the Naughty List to the Probationary Nice List.
2. Aggregate statistical data pertaining to juvenile infractions, including but not limited to: vandalism, theft of holiday decorations, unauthorized snowball combat, and cookie-related

misdemeanors.

3. Voluntary statements and body-worn camera (BWC) footage involving any incidents at local malls or toy stores where individuals may have falsely impersonated Santa Claus or misrepresented their Nice List status.

4. Any publicly available correspondence or complaints submitted to LVMPD referencing "Santa," "elves," "reindeer," or "unauthorized sleigh landings."

Legal Basis:

This request is made in accordance with NRS 239.010, which mandates that "all public books and public records of a governmental entity must be open at all times during office hours to inspection by any person," unless otherwise declared confidential by law. As a non-resident foreign entity with global jurisdiction, I assert my right to access these records as a "person" under the statute, and I affirm that this request is made for non-commercial, benevolent, and magical purposes.

If any portion of the requested records is deemed confidential or exempt, I request that you provide a written explanation citing the specific statutory exemption(s) under NRS 239.0107(1)(d).

Fee Waiver Request:

Given the public interest in ensuring equitable gift distribution and the non-commercial nature of this request, I respectfully request a waiver of any fees associated with the production of these records, pursuant to NRS 239.052.
