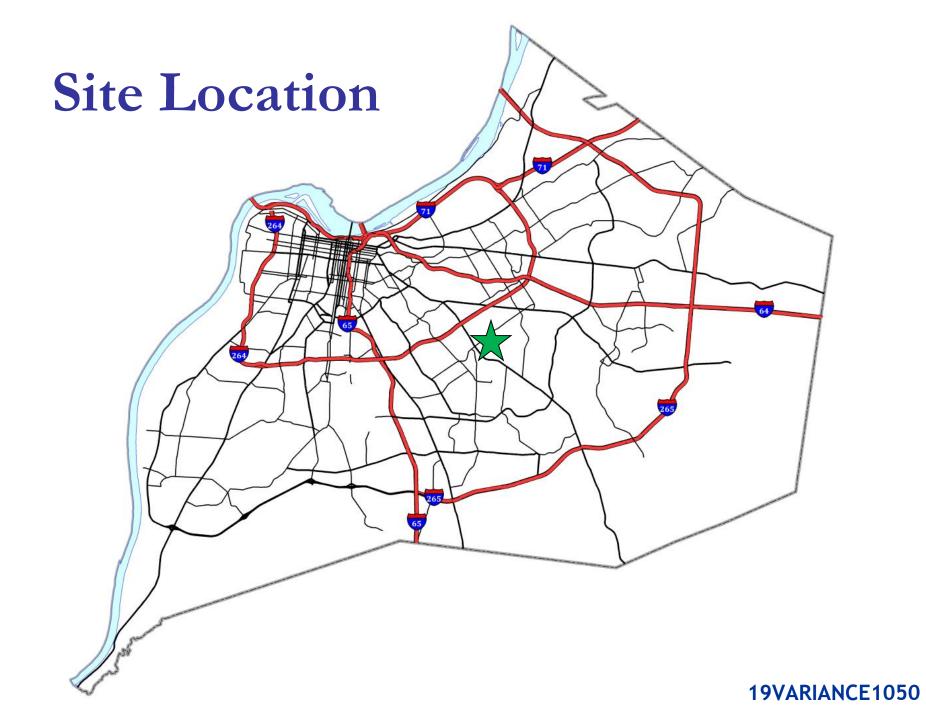

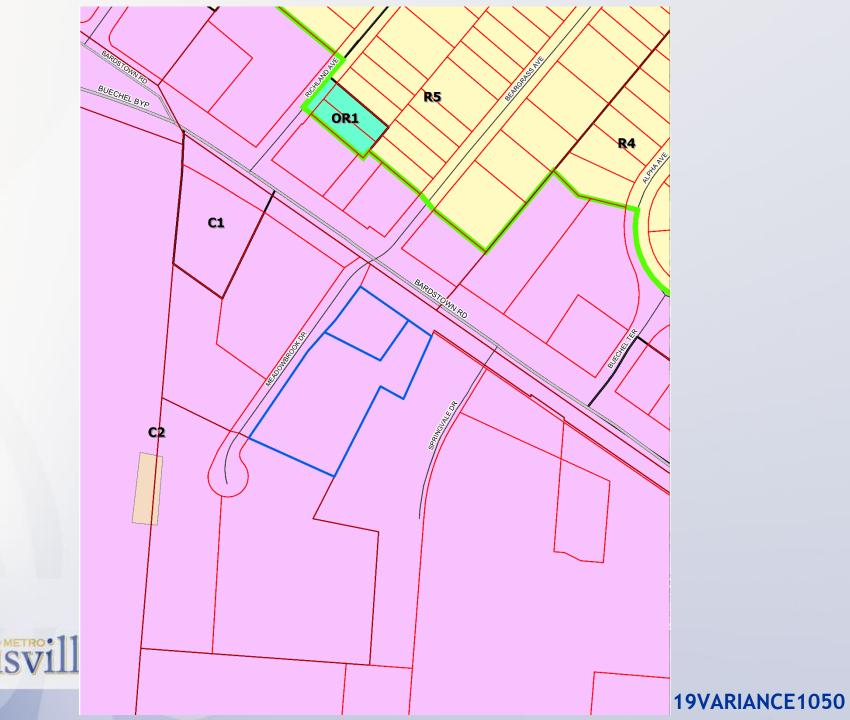


Case Summary / Background

- The applicant is proposing to construct a 2,940 square foot parts storage warehouse.

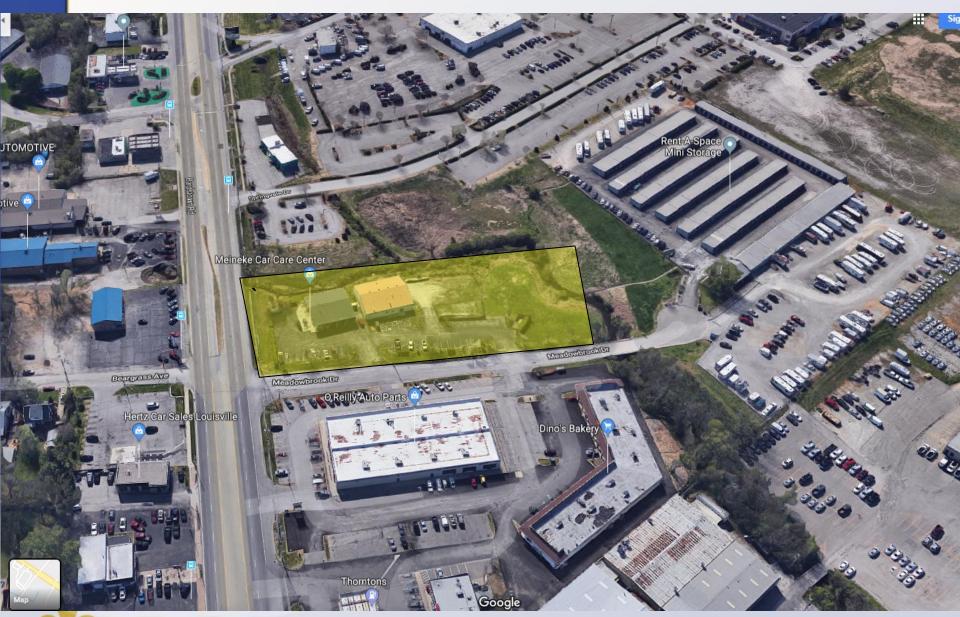
