- 2. On page two per the spreadsheet that was attached, \$20,000 of the \$163,069.49 amount appears to be <u>Transfer from CIF to operating budget</u>. We cannot process such via a CIF form since such a transfer always requires an ordinance.
- 3. IF that \$20,000 is meant to be the **Rep Host multiple shredding/junk pickup events in Republican districts**, then the problem is this would be a NDF function and fund and not CIF.

Since paving and sidewalk repair season is now going into winter break, there is time for you to correct the items and have the project funding reconsidered by Council.

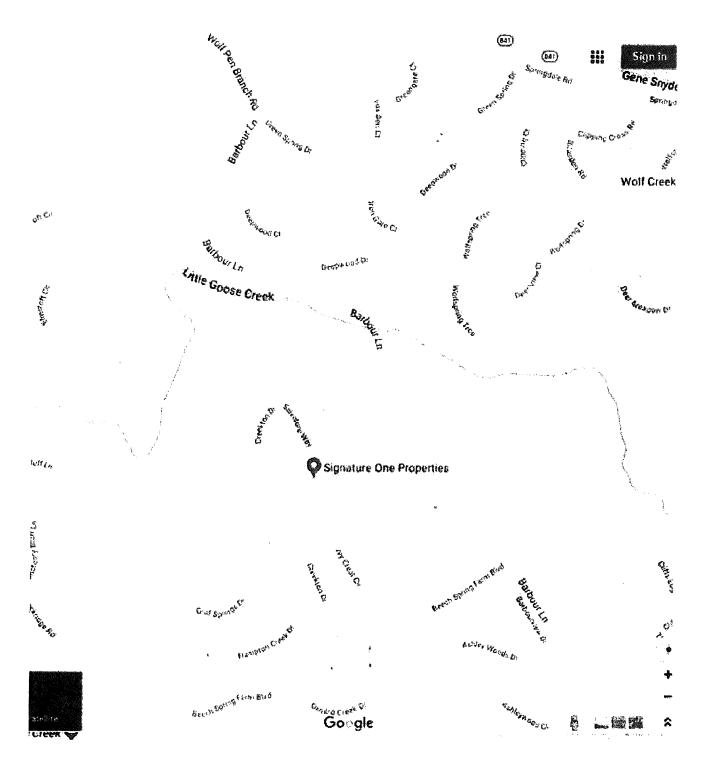

LaTonya is working on an appropriation for Councilman Kramer that will secure *some* of the needed funding for the Hunsinger Gardens Road Repair project. The attached engineer study that was paid for the association estimates repair costs between \$22,000 and \$40,000.

When we spoke yesterday, you mentioned visiting the site to evaluate whether or not you'll need an additional study to determine how best to proceed with repairs.

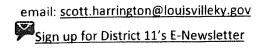

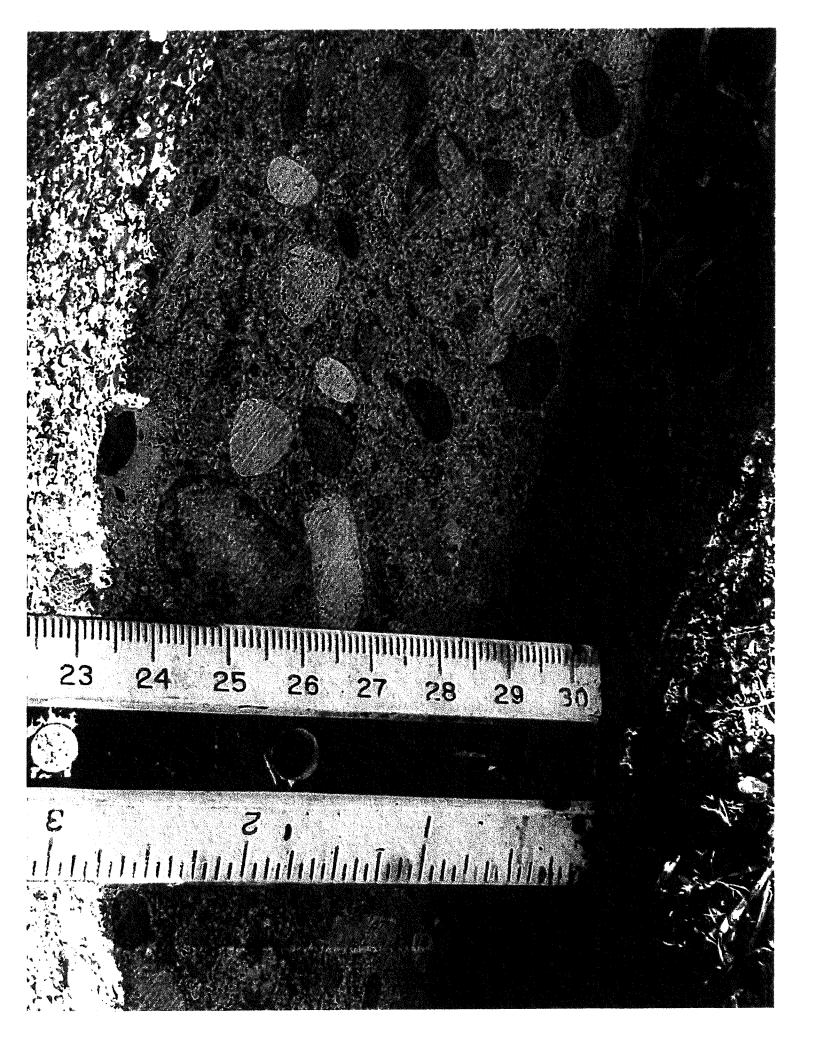

Hanka Builders appreciates the opportunity to quote on the above referenced work. We propose to furnish labor, material and equipment to complete the following work based on the specs provided:

#### Scope:

In putting together an estimate to repair the road, I figured, worst case scenario, the affected area to be 75' x 25 x 2' deep'. I fully understand that in reality we probably will only need to excavate about half. If we had to repair the entire area I came up with a figure around \$40,000(including asphalt/\$20,000 in Concrete Fill/14 dump trucks haul off).

My sense is that we can repair a much smaller area once we get a good look under the asphalt. I think the actual smaller repair plus the asphalt would come in around \$22,000. Once again this is just a guess. If you have a budget we could work together to optimize our time.

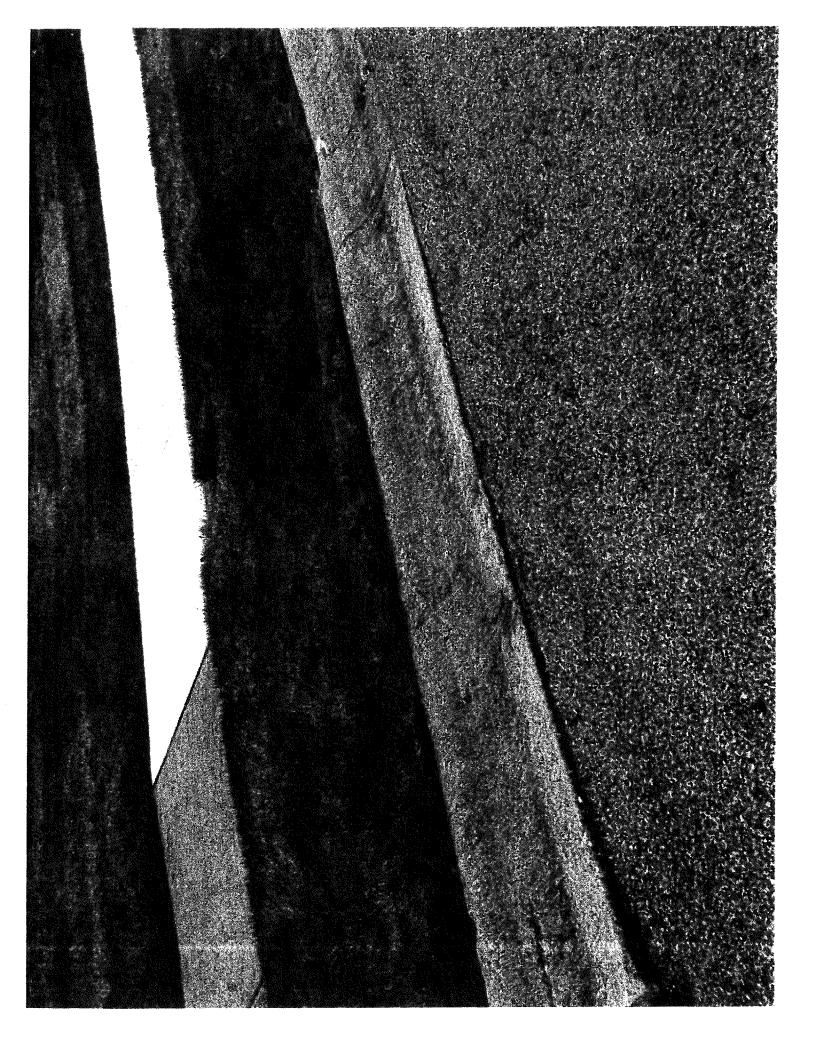
