OK, So I rode by there and have attached a few pictures. As you can see when the underpass was painted they did not tape off any of the lenses. To replace the lenses, a new LED, and a mogul base to convert to LED is more than replacing the whole fixture.

The fixtures and miscellaneous hardware are \$250.00 dollars apiece.

There are actually 18 fixtures under the underpass.

Total cost would be \$4,500.00 for all of the materials.

We would have 3rd shift change these out at night. It looks like all of the conduit system and service is in good shape.

I had a work order created to go down and look at his tonight to see what is working and make sure we have power to them.



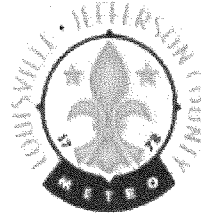
