- 5 Knock Out Roses – hot pink
- 30 'Becky' Shasta Daisy
- 50 Iris
- 50 Daylilies
- 15 Flats of annuals
- 7 cu yds Compost – to improve drainage & soil
- 5 cu yds Hardwood Mulch
- Pre and Post-emergence & Landscape Fertilizer
- Labor & Equipment for Landscaping

\*Annuals to be planted in the spring to provide a 'pop' of color throughout the whole growing season
