

Last year, the amphitheater had 82 events and a total annual attendance of over 127,000 . This summer promises to be bigger and better with more events, more variety, and more people!

We would like to request \$22,325.00 to support programming at the Iroquois Amphitheater in the summer of 2017 including: free movie nights, free and low cost arts events, festivals and any other events organized by Metro Parks that serve the amphitheater's mission to entertain, educate, and enrich our community and to strengthen the arts for future generations of artists and audience.
