

ENFORCEMENT OF PUBLIC UTILITY EASEMENT

Date August 28 1936

An easement for public utility purposes is hereby reserved on, over, under and within the strips and spaces upon this plat defined and bounded by dotted lines and marked "Public Utility Easement" including the right to the Utility Companies to remove and trim trees on said easement, and the branches of trees overlapping same, and to dispose of any other obstruction therein to the extent that it may be necessary for the proper installation and operation of Public Utilities within said strips and spaces.

There is also reserved to Public Electric Lighting Companies the right to run an underground conduit for street lights within a 24-inch space on the following lots with the right of ingress and egress for all necessary purposes in connection with the installation, operation, and maintenance of overhead and underground equipment
