CW Welch,

My division can employ a traffic control measure that should help to resolve your loading zone concerns. My recommendation is to install a (no parking zone) utilizing “thermoplastic” pavement markings which would serve to alert motorists and control traffic-flow within the confined space. The “thermoplastic” markings would yield a longer residual as compared to painted markings. You will find that over time this approach would be more cost-effective.....

The *cost estimate* for striping a “loading zone” @ 10616 W. Manslick Rd. is as follows:

- {Stripe “Loading-Zone” @ approximately (128) sq. ft.}
- Install (4”) thermoplastic striping(yellow) w/ retro-reflectivity

TOTAL COST = \$ 243.00

CW Welch,

Louisville Metro Public Works has reviewed the site where the loading zone is being requested. We should be able to help you with your request. Typically, a loading zone is granted through the application process. However, since the requested zone is located on private property it won't need LMPW approval. That does mean that the project will have to be funded by your office.

Usually signs are used to delineate the extents of a loading zone because they will last much longer than pavement markings. If you would prefer, though, we can stripe a zone.

The cost for (2) signs and posts will be \$210. If you would rather go with pavement markings I can have Kenny provide you with an estimate.

Please let me know how you would like to proceed. Let me know if you have any questions or if you would like to discuss this matter further.
