

I did a new estimate for providing new "Historic" concrete curbing around this island area. The items required would be sawcutting, new Historic Concrete Header Curb, topsoil, sod and a Mobilization charge. These are the costs for my Secondary contractor. My Primary contractor has a much higher Mob charge. I am also hoping that they would be willing to mobilize for something this small. The total cost would be **\$5,200**. I would also want to get Traffic's blessing on this concept too.

On a side note, I saved \$3,000 from the Speed & Lauderdale median island project. The contractor should invoice me this week for that project.

Good afternoon. Our neighborhood has a problem I am again asking for the City's help. I asked our previous representative but he declined to provide any assistance.

The attached pictures provide an overview of the issue we have. We have a small "island" that I care for. I cut the grass, decorate on holidays (U.S. flags) and even planted the tree you see in the picture when lightning killed the original. (Again, Tom Owen refused to assist us in replacing it. I bought it and planted it.)

My request, could you please see if you can provide a curb around this island to keep cars and trucks from driving through it and doing what you see in the pictures. I have repaired this damage (for the 10th+ time) and this will not stop without a curb!

There is a similar island at the top (up the hill) of Saratoga the city installed. I am asking for the city's help with this eye sore. If you can only provide "some" financial assistance, I will see if I can get the neighbors to donate some funds to cover any balance.

The curbs work! You can see from the (additional) pictures how the yards are destroyed from cars parking in the yards. We paid for the curb in front of our house and other neighbors have done the same. Those with curbs do not have the problem.
