**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ACCEPT A STATE GRANT TOTALING \$115,880 FROM THE COMMONWEALTH OF KENTUCKY, JUSTICE AND PUBLIC SAFETY CABINET, DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS TO BE USED BY THE LOUISVILLE METRO CORRECTIONS DEPARTMENT TO SUPPORT SIXTY ADDITIONAL LONG-TERM RESIDENTIAL SUBSTANCE ABUSE RECOVERY PROGRAM SLOTS (\$65,880) AS WELL AS A MEDICALLY ASSISTED TREATMENT FOR INMATES WITH OPIATE ADDICTION OR OTHER SUBSTANCE USE DISORDERS (\$50,000).**
