# **Project Description**

This is a joint project between TARC and District 22 who were originally splitting the cost 80% TARC, 20% District 22. (Total Project Cost: \$37,240. TARC Cost: \$29,792.16. D22 Cost: \$7,448.04.) The objective was to fund new TARC stops and improve safety features at the intersection of Bardstown Road at Cedar Look Drive. Public Works is overseeing the project. The work will consist of 100 Ft of sidewalk on the southbound side of the road, three sidewalk ramp improvements, one bench pad and one shelter pad. The shelter will be provided through TARC's existing contract with our shelter advertising contractor at no cost to D22. The final project cost has risen, and Public Works is requesting an additional \$1,360.00. This will go along with the original amount of \$7,448.04 which D22 contributed in November of 2020. This amount came from Fee in Lieu sidewalk funds, account #:8101 410 8211 148522 821344. District 22 will use CIF funds to add the additional \$1,360.00.

Last year (around this time) TARC approached Metro/District 22 about a pedestrian intersection/TARC Stop improvement project at Bardstown Road @ Cedar Look Drive. The details are below:

The project will consist of 100 Ft of sidewalk on the southbound side of the road, three sidewalk ramp improvements, one bench pad and one shelter pad. The shelter will be provided through TARC's existing contract with our shelter advertising contractor at no cost to D22.

I attached the project cost and below is an explanation of how the project will be split.

Total Project Cost: \$37,240 TARC Cost: \$29,792.16 D22 Cost: \$7,448.04

This cost is an estimate with a 20% contingency built in. So the cost for TARC and D22 will vary slightly depending on what the total cost actually comes out to. How the billing works is that our contractor will bill Public Works and then they will split the total between TARC and D22 and we will pay PW directly.

Since then, Metro's ability to crank out a permittable plan sheet for the state to grant us a KYTC Encroachment Permit has been delayed and foiled by the fact that PW's Microstation Software has basically broken down. TARC is wanting to move forward and is willing to add a design fee to this project. That fee would be \$6,800. With an 80/20% split, TARC is asking for another \$1,360 from District 22 to make this happen. Is this something that D22 can agree to or not?
