Total = \$4,500.00

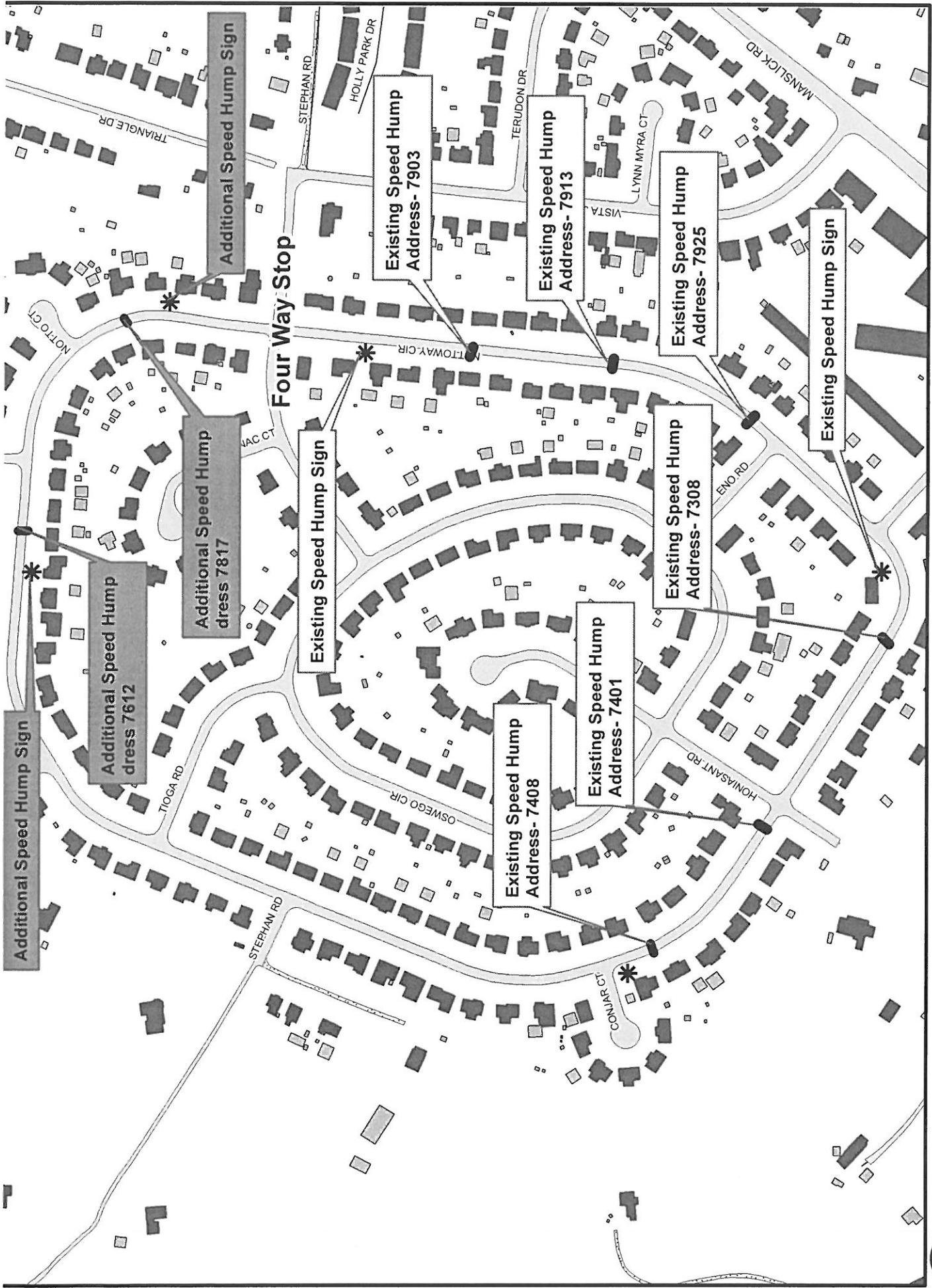

Good Afternoon Darlene –

Councilman Blackwell asked me to contact Public Works about installing another speed hump on the north end of Nottoway Circle around 7610. Attached is the proposal they provided with 5 possible speed hump locations – the area at 7610 was not wide enough so they proposed 7612 instead.

However, Public Works will not install ONLY the requested speed hump at 7610 because there would be too great of a distance between the existing speed humps on the south side. They would require that at least one other speed hump be installed – so the one at 7817 *and* 7612 or 7612 and the three on the west side of Nottoway.

Currently, speed humps costs \$2050 each and there would need to be one additional sign, which is \$200. If the neighborhood association would like to move forward with the placements at 7612 and 7817, the IHNA portion would be \$2150 (half of the total cost of \$4300).
