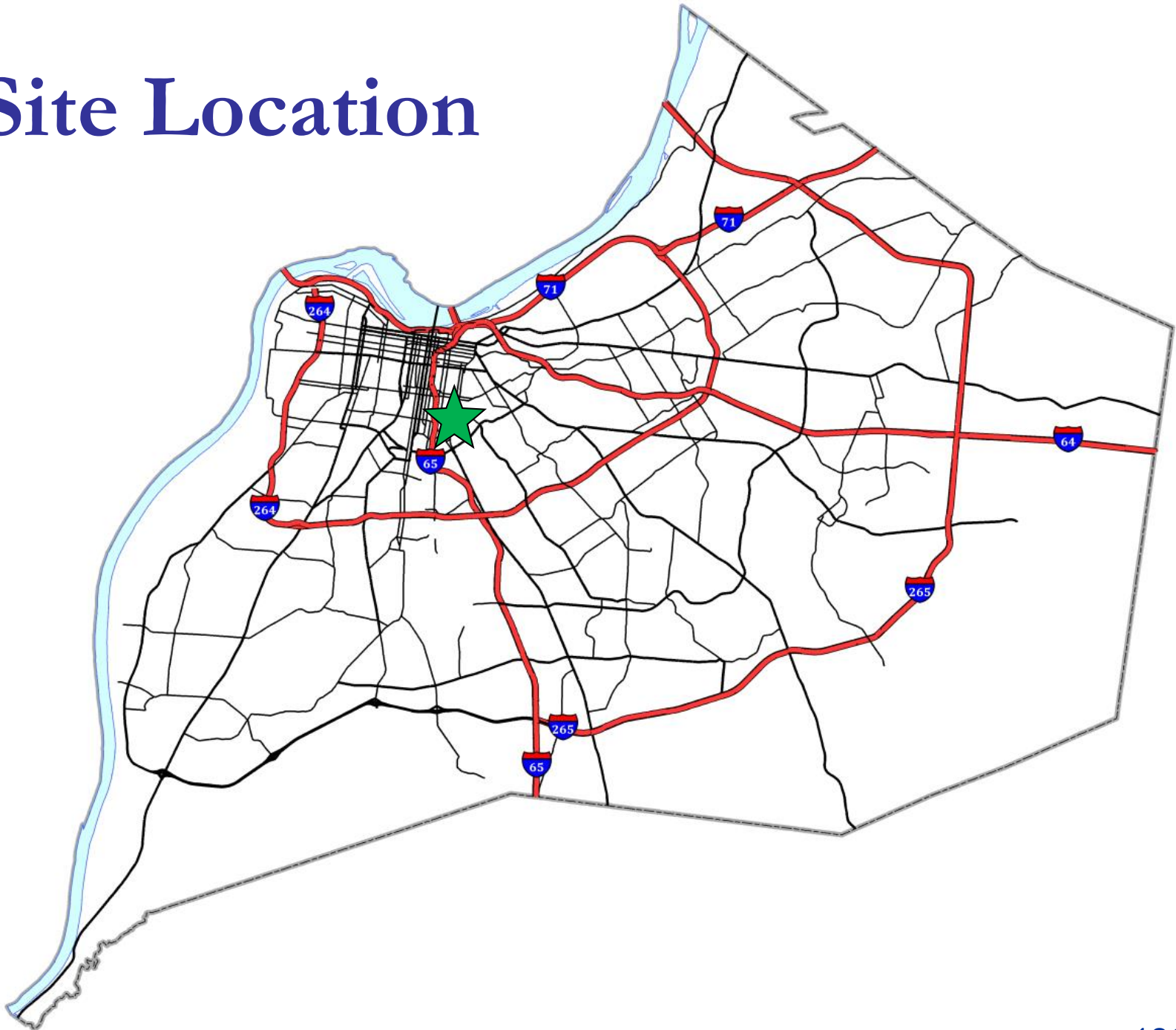

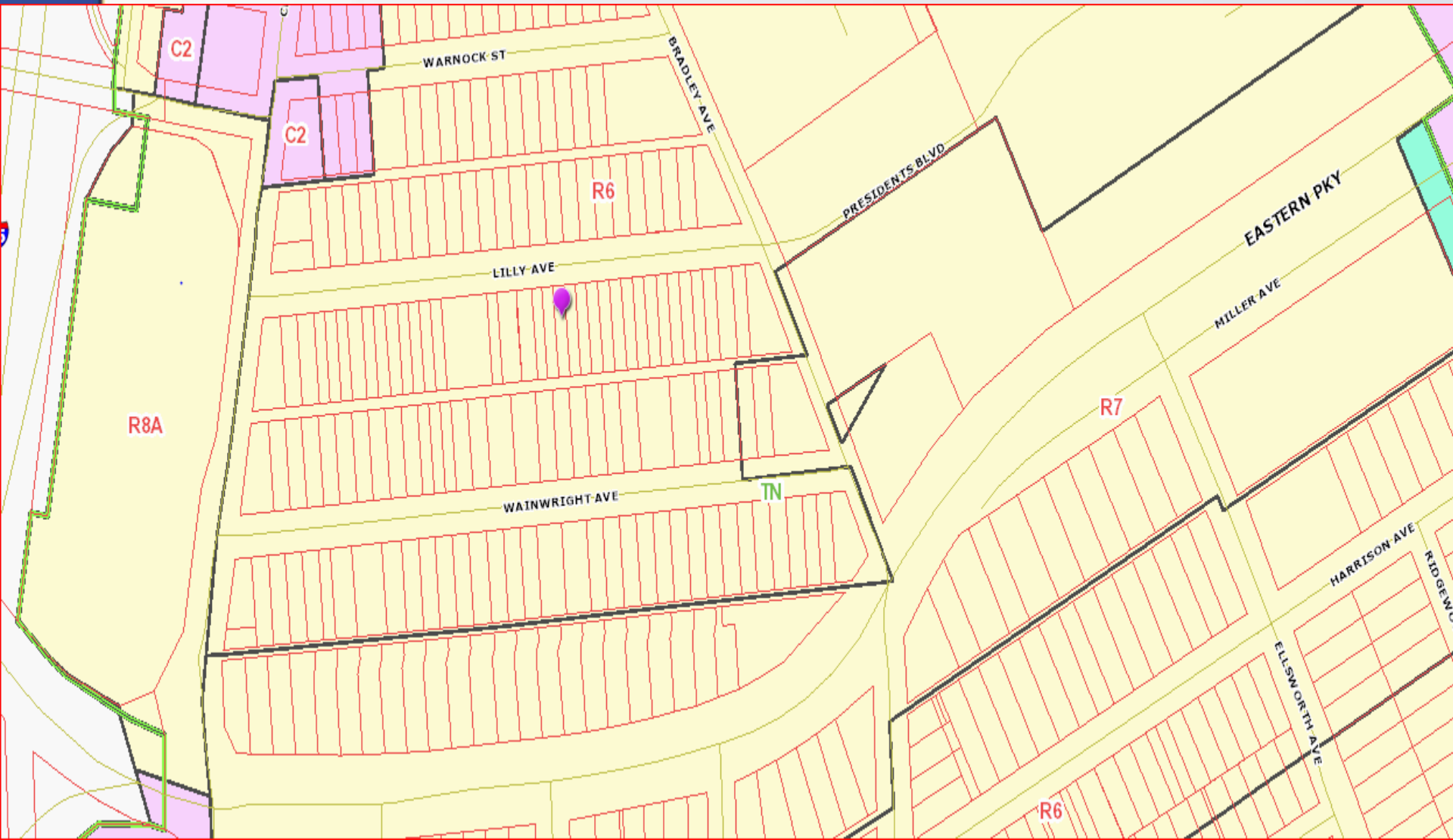

Case Summary / Background

Zoned R-6, Residential Multi-Family District

Traditional Neighborhood Form District

0.059 acre

1 Bedroom, 6 guests would be allowed

Applicant Limiting to 5 guests

Parking in the front and in the garage.

Parties will not be allowed.

Neighborhood Meeting on August 30, 2018, with 2 people attending; Councilwoman's Butler office (District 15) and President of St. Joseph Area Association.—No Concerns.

Conclusions

- The proposal meets the standard of review for the requested Conditional Use Permit.
- Based upon the information in the staff report, the testimony and evidence provided at the public meeting, the Board of Zoning Adjustment must determine if the proposal meets the standards established by the Land Development Code for the requested Conditional Use Permit.

Required Action

Approve or Deny

- Conditional Use Permit to allow short term rental of a dwelling unit not the primary residence of the host (LDC 4.2.63)

- Conditions of Approval
 1. Prior to commencement of any short term rental on the subject property, the host shall register the short term rental with Develop Louisville and with the Louisville Metro Revenue Commission. If the short term rental is not registered with Develop Louisville and with the Revenue Commission within 60 days of the approval of the minutes of this case, then the Conditional Use Permit shall be deemed null and void.
 2. The short term rental and host shall meet all additional provisions set forth in the Louisville Metro Code of Ordinances.
 3. Total number of guests will be limited to five, (5).
