

The honorary street name sign has been fabricated using the correct dimensions. The Stony Brook Dr street name sign is larger because of the 35 mph posted speed limit on Six Mile Ln. Because honorary signs aren't the official street name sign, we wouldn't make the text the same size as the official street name as it will create confusion by taking motorists attention away from the official street name. Additionally, if we increased the text size of the sign, the sign would be extremely long due to all of the letters used. Most street names don't have that many characters.
