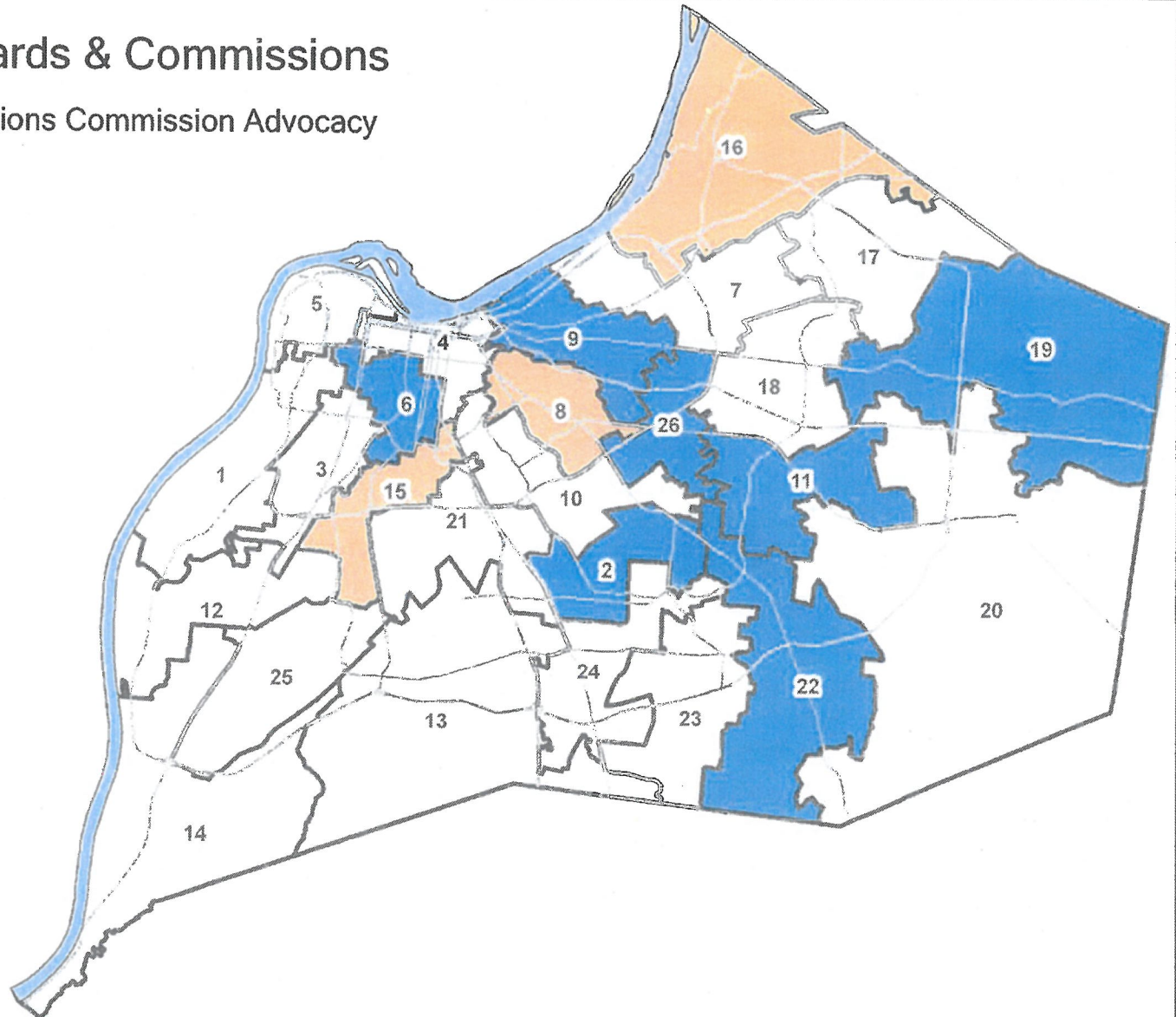

HOW APPOINTED	Mayor with approval of Council
EX OFFICIO MEMBERS	
QUALIFICATION OF MEMBERS	Members shall reside in Jefferson County and no more than one member shall reside within any council district. The members so appointed shall include persons who are representative of the several social, economic, cultural, ethnic, and racial groups that comprise the population of Metro Louisville.
COUNCIL APPROVAL OF APPOINTMENT	Yes
COMPENSATION	Members shall serve without compensation, but subject to the approval of the Mayor and within the limits imposed by the budget, they shall be allowed the necessary expenses attendant upon their duties.
TERM OF APPOINTMENT	3 years and until successors are appointed and qualified. Members shall be eligible for reappointment for additional terms.
VACANCY APPOINTMENT	Members appointed to fill vacancies fill out the vacant member's term of office.
AUTOMATIC REAPPOINTMENT UNDER KRS 65.008(2)?	NO
REMOVAL	Members are subject to removal by the Mayor at the discretion of the Mayor.
POWERS	Act as conciliator in controversies involving intergroup and interracial relations.
BONDING AUTHORITY	No

PURPOSE	The Human Relations Commission-Advocacy shall endeavor to promote and secure mutual understanding and respect among all economic, social, religious, ethnic, and social groups in the metropolitan area, and shall act as conciliator in controversies involving intergroup and interracial relations. The Human Relations Commission-Advocacy shall cooperate with federal,

	state, and other local agencies in efforts to develop harmonious intergroup and interracial relations, and shall endeavor to enlist the support of civic, religious, labor, industrial, and commercial groups, and civic leaders dedicated to the improvement of human relations and elimination of discriminatory practices.
MEETING	Shall meet as often as it deems necessary, but shall not meet less than bi-monthly.
