
AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 168, SERIES 2021 RELATING TO THE SECOND ROUND OF THE AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN (ARP) LOCAL FISCAL RECOVERY BY REPLACING THE PERMANENT SUPPORTIVE HOUSING (LAT-51) PROJECT FUNDING IN THE AMOUNT OF \$11,417,313 WITH ARP HOME FUNDS AND ADDING A NEW PROJECT TITLED SHELTER RENOVATIONS TO BE ADMINISTERED BY DEVELOP LOUISVILLE.




SECTION II: This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and approval or otherwise becoming law.


