To provide the highest quality of structured care to our youth through a variety of creative programs and services that teach accountability and provide protection to the community.




Our Department Structure & Leadership Team

Youth Detention Services is comprised of three branches: Secure Detention, Community Based Services, and Administrative Support


- **Administrative Services/Ms. Claycomb** - manages the business affairs of the organization
- **Secure Detention/Ms. Day** - a 96 bed facility that works to foster a safe environment while providing structured supervision and programming to youth pending disposition
- **Community Based Services/Ms. Kirby** - comprised of three units: Community Supervision (HIP/HSP), Alternative Placement Services (12 bed emergency shelter), and Court Process (5 sworn peace officers)




Who we served?


Average Daily Population
