Here is our District 15 list for requested Trash containers for the Oakdale Neighborhood. Per our prior conversation I want to be sure these containers cost \$583.00 per container, installed with a concrete base & "OAKDALE NEIGHBORHOOD" on each one? That total would then be \$5830.00. If this is all correct then please email me back and I will start the process for the appropriation.

Below is the list of trash container locations and the notes from Public Works (John Akridge/303-0250 or john.akridge@louisvilleky.gov) They inspected each area and made the suggestions you, see for the contractor. Per Public Works, No permits are needed. Thank you for all your help!

1.) 5th Street at Evelyn Ave – the S.W. corner, at the empty lot. Should be OK with pad

- 2.) 5th Street at W. Whitney Ave close to the TARC sign at 4101 S. 5th Street. Should be able to place on existing boarding pad opposite end from FH.
- 3.) 5th Street at Kenton Street close to the TARC sign at 3901 5th Street not much room on 5th street with utility covers, may be able to place on Kenton side with pad.
- 4.) Longfield Ave at Bellevue Ave at 716 Longfield Ave. Should be OK, will need pad.
- 5.) Longfield Ave at Cliff Ave at 900 Longfield Ave. This one looks tight with ROW but I think it can be done w/ a pad built behind sidewalk.
- 6.) Beecher Street at Warren Ave S.W. corner, at Wyandotte Park. Should be OK will need a pad.
- 7.) Beecher Street at Peachtree Ave at 1031 Beecher Street. Appears to be room on Peachtree side will need pad
- 8.) Camden Ave at Bellevue Ave at church lot, replacing Metro wire trash basket there now. Didn't see existing, but should be OK with PAD.
- 9.) Henry Ave at Hathaway Ave close to stop sign, at empty lot across from MBS. Should be OK will need pad.
- 10.) Dresden Ave at Warren Ave N.E. corner behind the sidewalk O.K. with a pad
