I have asked the city contractor to provide the cost estimate to remove the declining ash tree at 4705 Lowe Rd. In regards to replacing the tree, I do not feel that it is suitable to replace especially with a low flowering tree because of the visibility for motorists exiting Regency Way Woods and Des Pres Park. It is so hard to see to the right when exiting as it is and tree(s) will make it harder. If there was a light at the intersection (with a "No turn on Red") I would recommend replacement. If you or CW Parker care to meet on site to see this cross visibility problem, I am happy to. I am out for training most of this week but can look at my schedule for the coming weeks.

As soon as I get the cost estimate I will send over to you for review. Thank you
