**AN ORDINANCE CLOSING A PORTION OF FACTORY LANE AND BEING IN LOUISVILLE METRO (CASE NO. 18STREETS1013).**

**WHEREAS**, the Louisville Metro Planning Commission, as set forth in its minutes and records of Case No. 18STREETS1013, has recommended to the Legislative Council of the Louisville/Jefferson County Metro Government (the "Council") that a portion of Factory Lane be closed; and




**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE LOUISVILLE/JEFFERSON COUNTY METRO GOVERNMENT AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION I:** That a portion of Factory Lane and being in Louisville Metro, as more particularly described in the minutes and records of the Planning Commission in Case No. 18STREETS1013 and as shown on the attached closure exhibit, be closed subject to all existing easements of record and all existing utility easements or rights enjoyed by said utility companies as the result of being located in, on or over said right-of-way.

**SECTION II:** This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and approval.
