Louisville Metro Public Works has reviewed the above listed intersection and determined making improvements associated with pavement markings and signage will be the best solution to address concerns associated with this intersection. Attached is our proposal. As designed, this project is estimated to cost \$2,338. Additionally, if deemed necessary after a review of this location approximately one year after this proposed installation, we would like to consider installing 12 delineator posts at an additional cost of \$1,752.00 (for a project total of \$4,090). We think this project would positively impact safety at this location, however, it will be difficult to manage based on current budgetary constraints. Would Council be willing to partner with LMPW for this project? Please let me know how you would like to proceed, if you have any questions or if you would like to discuss this matter further.
