Councilwoman Fowler,

I talked with Andrew about this and then went out this morning and looked at Pierce and Blaze again to see what the difference was. Pierce was considered a new curb, meaning no curb removal was necessary. Blaze already has existing curb and will require curb removal before new curb and be constructed. Removing old curb adds to the cost. There is also a good deal more curb that will need replacing. Pierce was 279 feet of curb and Blaze will be 538 feet. Pierce required less seed and straw as well. I redid the estimate using standard curb instead of historic and no earth fill (it shouldn't be necessary in the end). I also added asphalt and reduced the 20% contingency to 5% since this is a pretty strait forward job. The total came to \$21,503.61. I hope that helps.

Header curb is unfortunately very expensive but very durable. You only see 6 inches of the curb sticking up from the pavement but it goes another one and a half foot down below the pavement. It's also reinforced with rebar so it will take a hit when a car tire slams into it. I hope that helps!

Cindi,

Thank you for your patience To improve the entrance at Sun Valley Estates you would need to repave, raise up the median and add a header curb, replace sidewalk ramps, adjust two catch basins, add curb and gutter around the sidewalk ramps and remove the ditch headwalls at Bethany Ln. I attached a few photos showing how the median curb would change. IMAG0041 is a picture of a raised median with a header curb and IMAG0050 is a picture of the curent median at Blaze Way. If you raised the median and added a header curb that should keep cars off the median. The cost of milling and repaving the entrance would be \$8,882.88. I included the estimate for the paving because the road has a very low rating of 12/100. Because Blaze Way is a local road the money to pave would come from your funds. That being the case you could use your yearly paving allocation. The cost for all other improvements are below.

The curbing is bad or non existent on some. I would like to replace them all and get some uniformity plus work with Brightside to do some plantings in the fall. The one that I am working with the neighbors on at present is the Blaze Way entry. It doesn't look too bad but the curbing is like a drive entrance and people are parking on it and we are going to plant it this fall and don't want it being driven on. Let me know if you need help locating them or if you need more info. I included all so you can make one trip do it even though I may not do all of them at one time.
