



Change in Population by County: 2000 to 2010




Components of Kentucky Population Change, 2010-2014



Personal Current Transfer Receipts in Constant (2012) Dollars: Kentucky




Total Government Expenditures as Percentages of GDP, 1950-2013




Jefferson County, Kentucky 2010 Population Pyramids






Asian Alone, Not Hispanic or Latino




Jefferson County, Kentucky 2010 Population Pyramids


