Staffing Solutions

- •3 Full-time Library Coordinators (Main Library, Southwest, Northeast)
 - Essential for maintaining the work of the Education Team, these positions focus on large program initiatives within assigned regions, as well as throughout the system.
- •3 Full-time Librarians (Main Library, Shawnee, Northeast)
 - Allows for Kentucky Genealogy & History Collection to maintain full hours, boosts staffing at Shawnee to avoid unanticipated closures and provides adult programming capacity, and provides a much needed Children's Librarian at Northeast.
- •6 Full-time Library Assistants (Main Library, Shively, Portland, Newburg, Fairdale, Floating)
 - Ensures continuation of Adult Outreach Services, and boosts staffing at locations that run the greatest risk of unanticipated closures due to staffing emergencies.
- •1 Part-time Library Assistant (Western)
 - Boosts staffing to avoid unanticipated closures due to staffing emergencies. Also provides additional capacity for offering programs and services.

Staffing Solutions

- •4 Full-time Library Clerks (Main Library (2), Western, Shively)
 - Boosts staffing at locations that run the greatest risk of unanticipated closures due to staffing emergencies. Also improves public service capacity, allowing reference staff to offer additional programming.
- •1 Part-time Library Clerk (Main Library)
 - Allows for the transfer of Interlibrary Loan services to the Content Management Department, freeing Library Clerks at Main to focus on direct public service.
- •3 Part-time Pages (Main Library, South Central, Northeast)
 - Provides capacity for keeping up with the substantial volume of activity at these locations.
