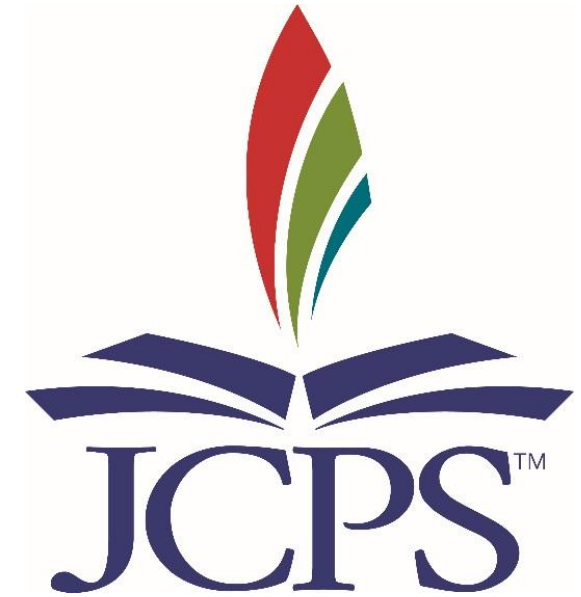

Challenges

- Devices, connectivity
- New way of connecting, collaborating for students, staff
- Delivery of special education, family support services, mental health and other services
- Safe delivery of paper packets, meals
- Estimated 1 million meals served by end of the school year

- **313-CARE (2273)**
Launched this month for connecting to non-instructional services normally provided to students in the school building. Operated by school counselors, mental health practitioners, Family Resource Youth Services coordinators, and coordinators from the departments of Early Childhood, Health Services and Community Supports.
- **313-HELP (4357)**
Launched in 2016 for general district information, school, and instructional resource help.

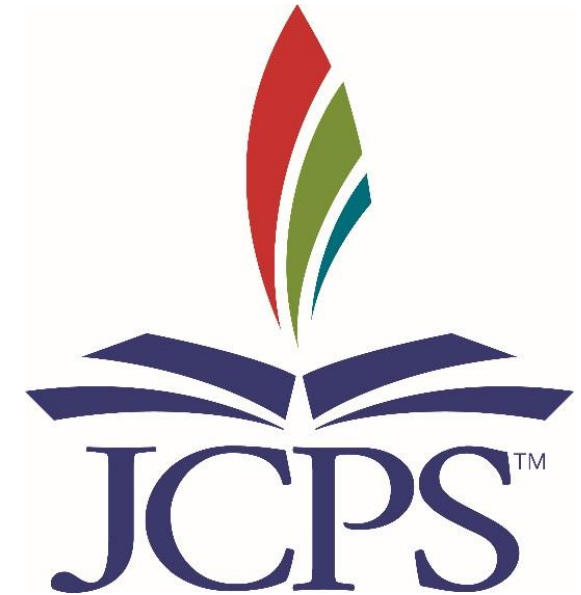


Grades, Graduation, Testing

- State Testing
 - Waived for FY20 school year by the U.S. Education Department and KY Department of Education
- Advanced Placement (AP)
 - Performance on AP tests do not factor into final grades. Visit College Board website for future testing dates.
- International Baccalaureate (IB)
 - No final exams for IB. IB is using “internal assessments” that are used throughout the year, typically for benchmarking progress, to determine final IB score. Visit IB website for details.
- Graduation
 - Students will receive final grades and transcripts as they always have. Seniors satisfactorily participating in NTI will receive a course grade equal-to or better-than their class grade on March 13.
 - District announcement later this week regarding virtual graduation ceremonies. Stay tuned!
