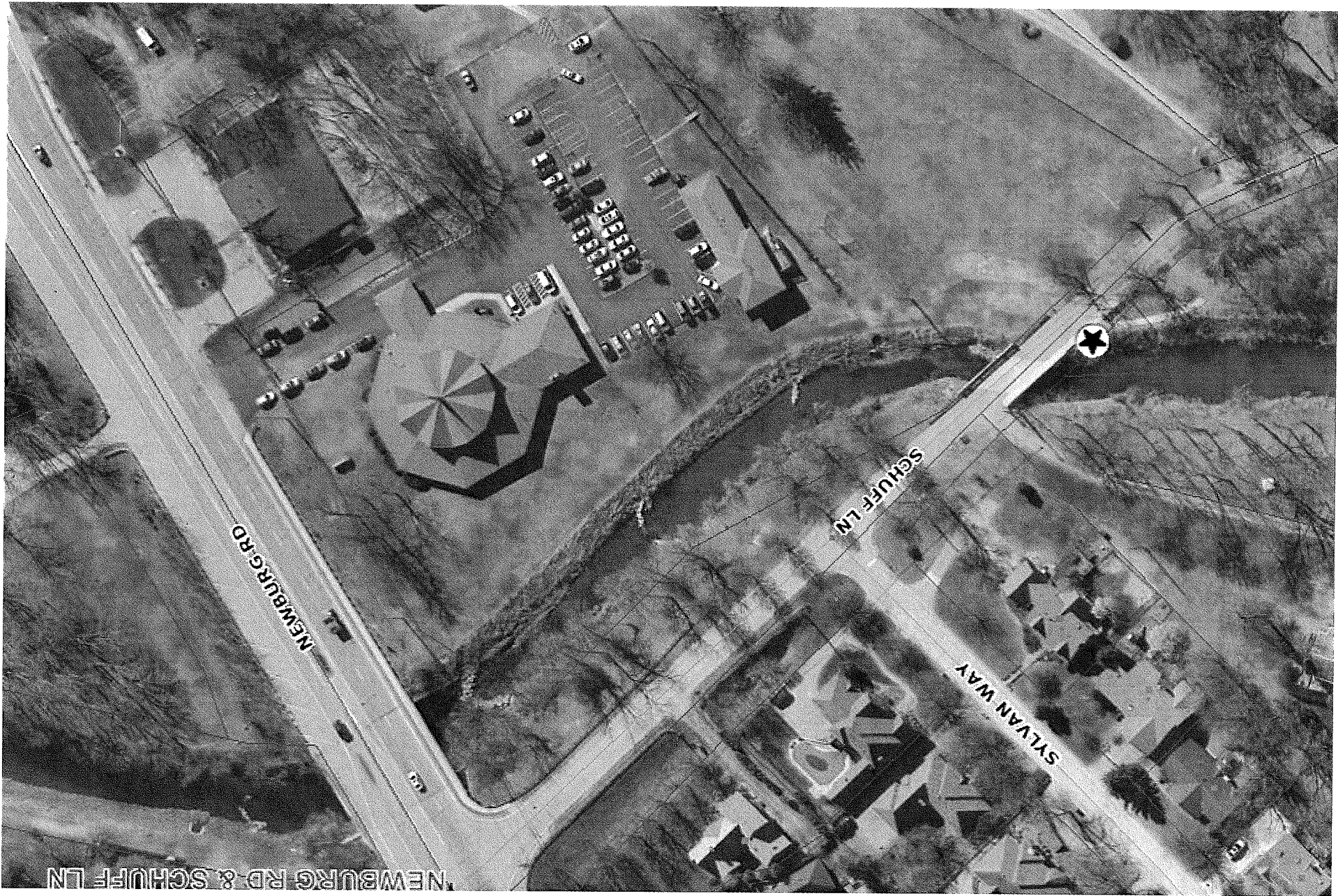

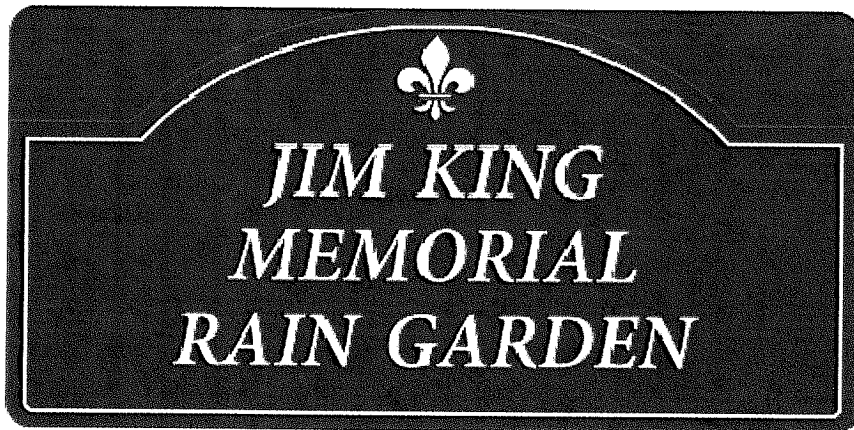

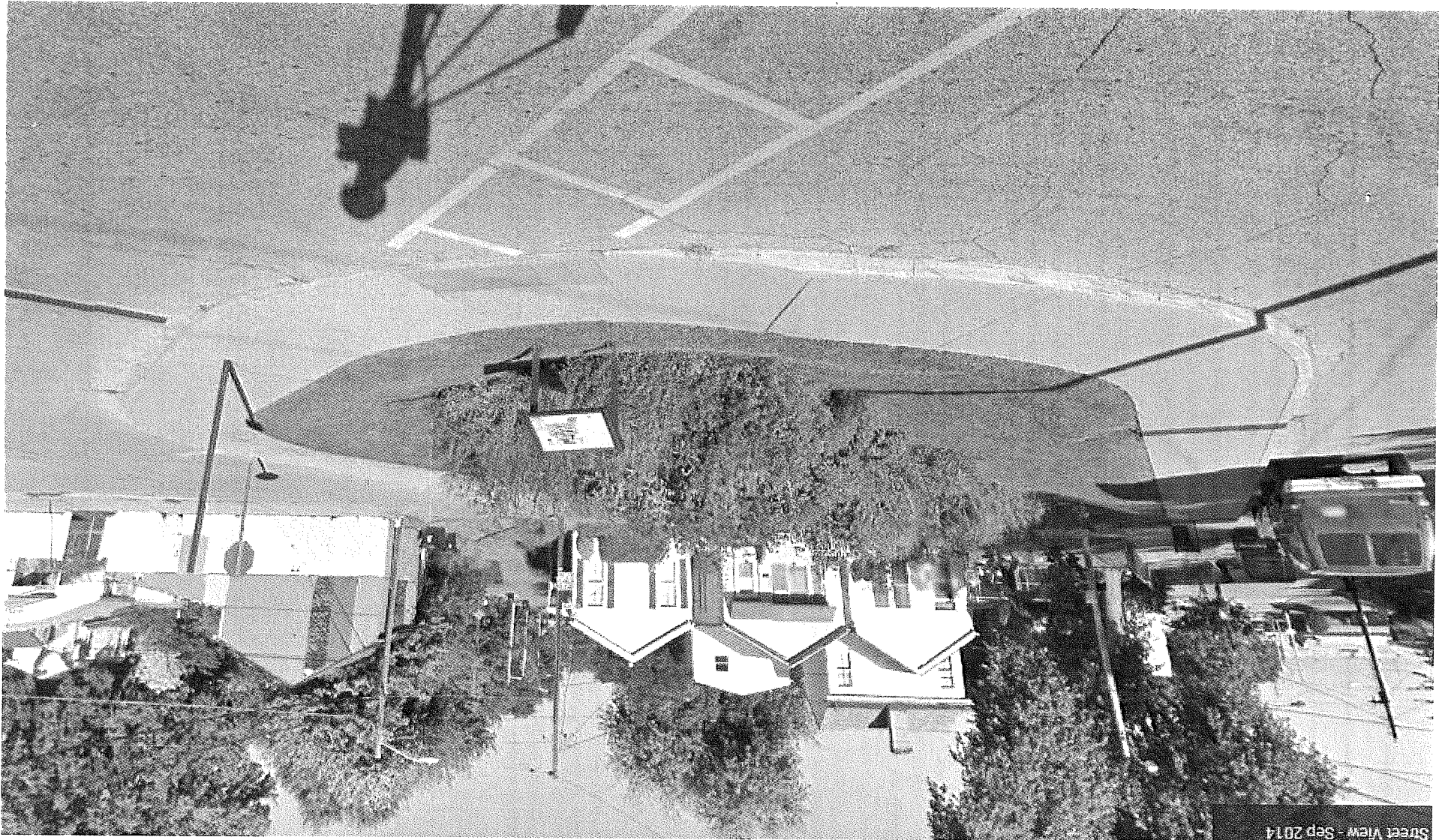
Stuart,

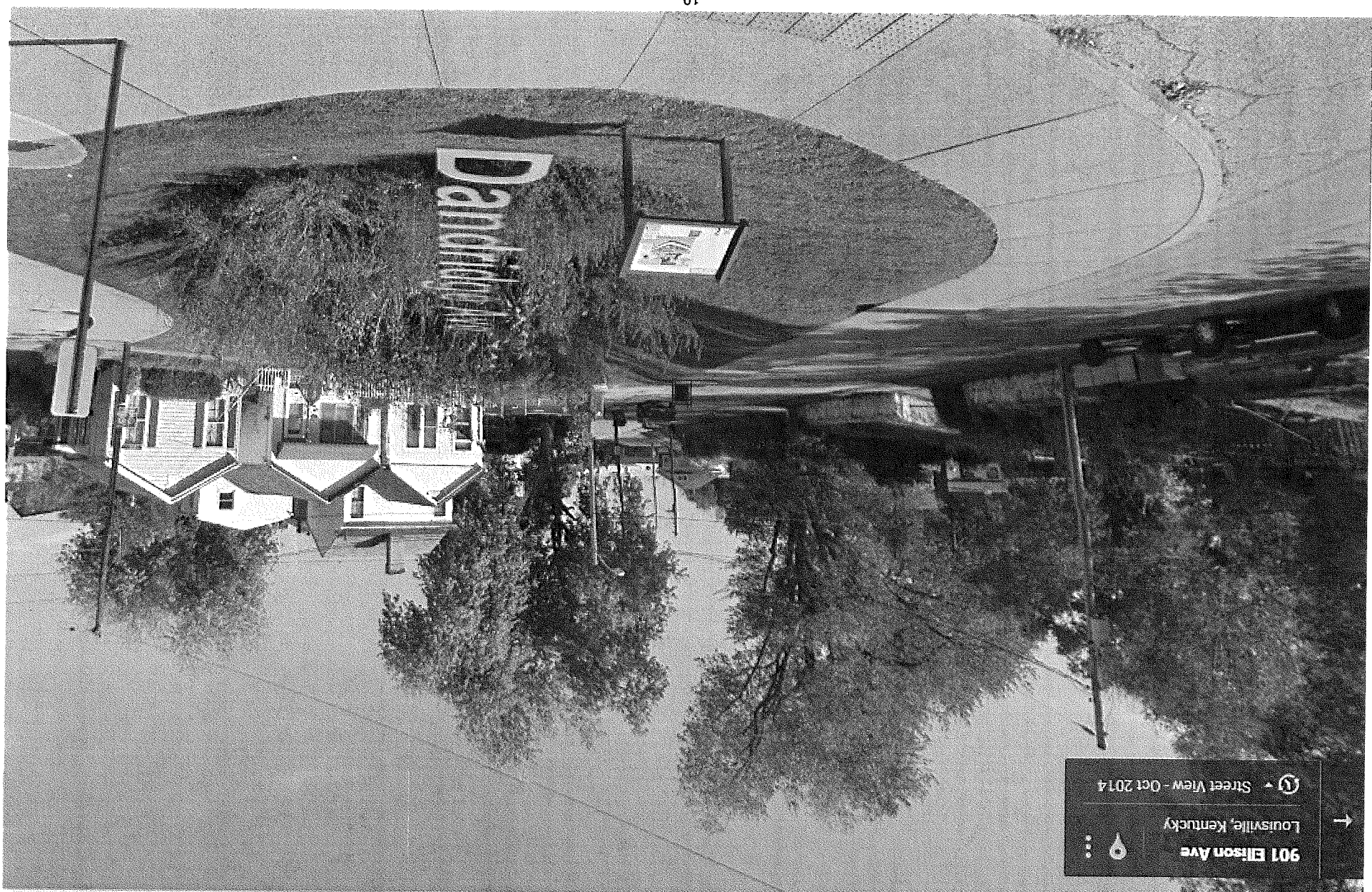
