Councilwoman George would appreciate if consideration could be given for the recycle green color for the S 3<sup>rd</sup> St slatted litter receptacles as was done for District 8.

### Recycle Green Slatted litter receptacles

- S 3<sup>rd</sup> St and W Wampum + Concrete Pad if needed (Northeast corner by the interstate sign) **\$1,245**
- S 3<sup>rd</sup> St and W Wellington Ave (Southeast corner on the concrete by the bus stop) **\$945**
- S 3<sup>rd</sup> St and W Kenwood Way + Concrete Pad if needed (Northwest corner by the bus stop) **\$1,245**
- S 3<sup>rd</sup> St and W Southland Blvd (Southwest corner) **\$945**
- S 3<sup>rd</sup> St and Gheens Ave (Southwest corner on the concrete by the bus stop near 6000 S 3<sup>rd</sup> St) **\$945**
- S 3<sup>rd</sup> St and N Arbor Park (Southeast corner on the concrete by the bus stop) **\$945**

### Black Slatted litter receptacles

- Intersection of Southern Pkwy and W Kenwood Way next to the benches **\$945**
- Preston Hwy and Durrett Lane on the concrete by the bus stop (Preston @ 4276 Stop ID: 21790) on the Northeast corner **\$945**

### Decorative litter receptacle

- Durrett Lane and Trinity Circle with the neighborhood name "Trinity Park" + Concrete Pad **\$898**


