**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 083, SERIES 2022 AND ORDINANCE NO. 084, SERIES 2022 RELATING TO THE FISCAL YEAR 2022-2023 OPERATING AND CAPITAL BUDGETS, RESPECTIVELY, BY TRANSFERRING \$75,000.00 FROM THE DISTRICT 17 NEIGHBORHOOD DEVELOPMENT FUND TO THE DISTRICT 17 CAPITAL INFRASTRUCTURE FUND AND BY TRANSFERRING \$30,000 FROM THE DISTRICT 19 NEIGHBORHOOD DEVELOPMENT FUND TO THE DISTRICT 19 CAPITAL INFRASTRUCTURE FUND (AS AMENDED).**







***Comments: The ordinance was amended to add District 19's request to transfer \$30,000.00 from its NDF account to its CIF account. Currently, District 19 has \$171,986.44 NDF unappropriated balance and \$25,726.91 CIF unappropriated balance. The \$30,000.00 transfer will be used to fund the LMPD license plate recognition cameras cost referenced in CIF020923LMPD19.***

***Currently, District 17 has \$206,261.37 NDF unappropriated balance and \$336,825.53 CIF unappropriated balance. District 17 is requesting to transfer \$75,000.00 from its NDF account to its CIF account to assist with funding some aesthetic/mobility improvements to a few major corridors in District 17 and potentially some improvements to the two metro parks in District 17.***
