Can you give a breakdown of each? The turf, national organization and irrigation? Thanks for your quick responses. I can start the paperwork as soon as CM Yates approves.

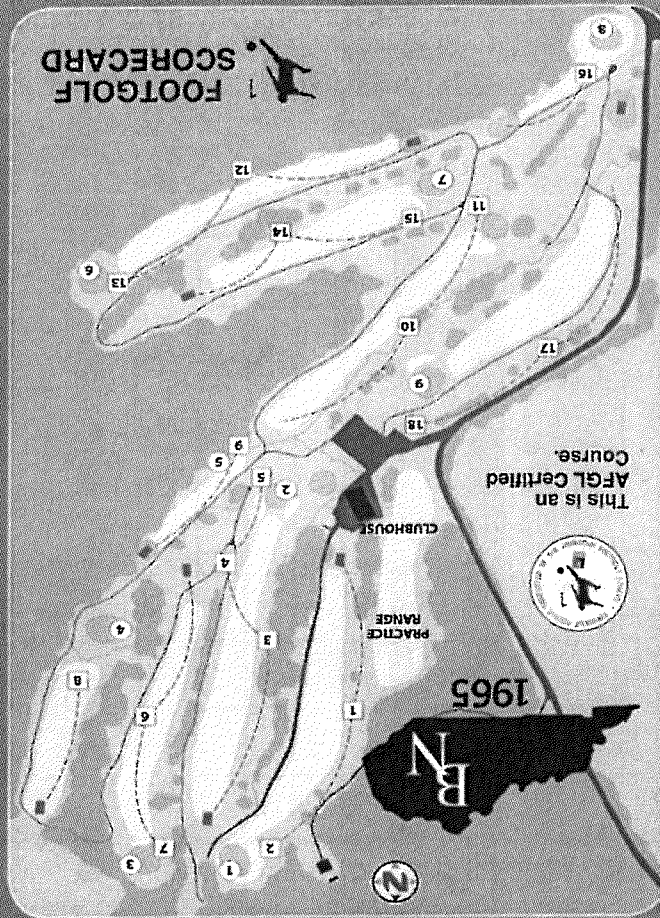

Hey David I hope all is going well. We had spoken awhile back about a FootGolf facility in your district. You had mentioned you might be willing to help me with some of our cost. Well we are ready to pull trigger on this – we have been working with in house staff to construct. We have about \$7500 in cost including joining national organization which gives recognition to our facility. Internally we have designed an 18-hole course inside 9-hole Bobby Nichols GC. Both front and back 9 ends at parking lot so a person could play only 9-holes if they desire. We really think this is going to be pretty cool. Our goal is to open labor day weekend. We still have some work to complete to make our greens better – but what we have looked at across region we might be one of nicest courses around. Please let me know what you think.

- Do not walk on Golf Greens.
- Wear appropriate clothes. Since we play on a golf course, Golf apparel is preferred. Soccer cleats are not allowed at anytime.
- Please make sure to keep up with the group in front of you. Groups falling behind our pace of play standard will be moved forward to recapture their position on the course. Pace of play: 1 hour 7 minutes for nine holes and 2 hours 15 minutes for 18.
- No personal or outside food or beverage is allowed
- Please respect the golfers.

**FootGolf Basic Rules**

- Wear appropriate clothing - golf cap, collared shirt and athletic socks are preferred.
- Review the score card and wait for your turn. Make sure your kick will not interfere with other players.
- Your ball must be easy to identify.

- Kick off your ball from behind the tee markers.
- The player furthest from the hole is the first to kick the ball.
- The ball must be played in a simple movement. You are not allowed to push the ball with the top or bottom of your foot. Your foot should be set separate from the ball, clearly behind, before each kick.

- Wait to play until the ball has completely come to rest. (It is not legal to slip the ball from rolling with the wind).
- Out of bounds markers are associated with white stakes. Place the ball within 2 steps from where the ball crossed between the white stakes receiving a one stroke penalty.
- Play the ball from where it lies. You are not allowed to move the ball or remove jammed objects. Exception: You may move the spot sand in the ball when it may obstruct the other player's kick or ball in any way.
- The order of play is established based on the score of the previous hole. The player with the best score will kick off first on the next hole followed by the second, etc.
- If the ball lands in a water hazard, retrieve or replace it within 2 steps from the closest land point from where the ball entered the hazard (announced by red flag), receiving a one stroke penalty or you can place the ball at the position of the previous kick and receive one stroke penalty.
