Louisville Metro Public Works Traffic Engineering has no objection to Mrs. Baribeau's proposal to install a fence on her property behind the existing bushes. The intersection operates as an all way stop control and there have been 5 documented crashes since January 1, 2016 (11/4/16, 5/17/17, 5/20/17, 6/18/18, & 1/22/19). We are going to relocate the stop sign and post for Dorothy Ave closer to the stop bar and refresh the stop bar to ensure an approaching motorist has the best visibility possible of motorists approaching on Douglass Blvd. Please let me know if you have any questions or if need anything else from me.
