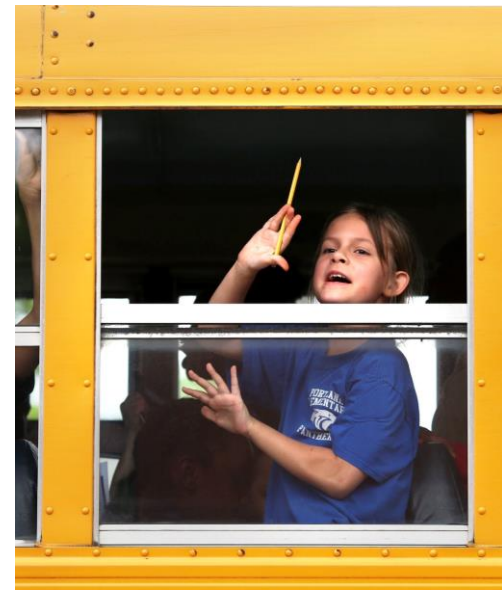

- 8 REGULAR DENTAL CLINICS AND MULTIPLE EPISODIC CLINICS
- ANTI-VAPING CAMPAIGN
- **COMING SOON: EXPANDED SCHOOL-BASED MEDICAID BILLING OPPORTUNITIES**

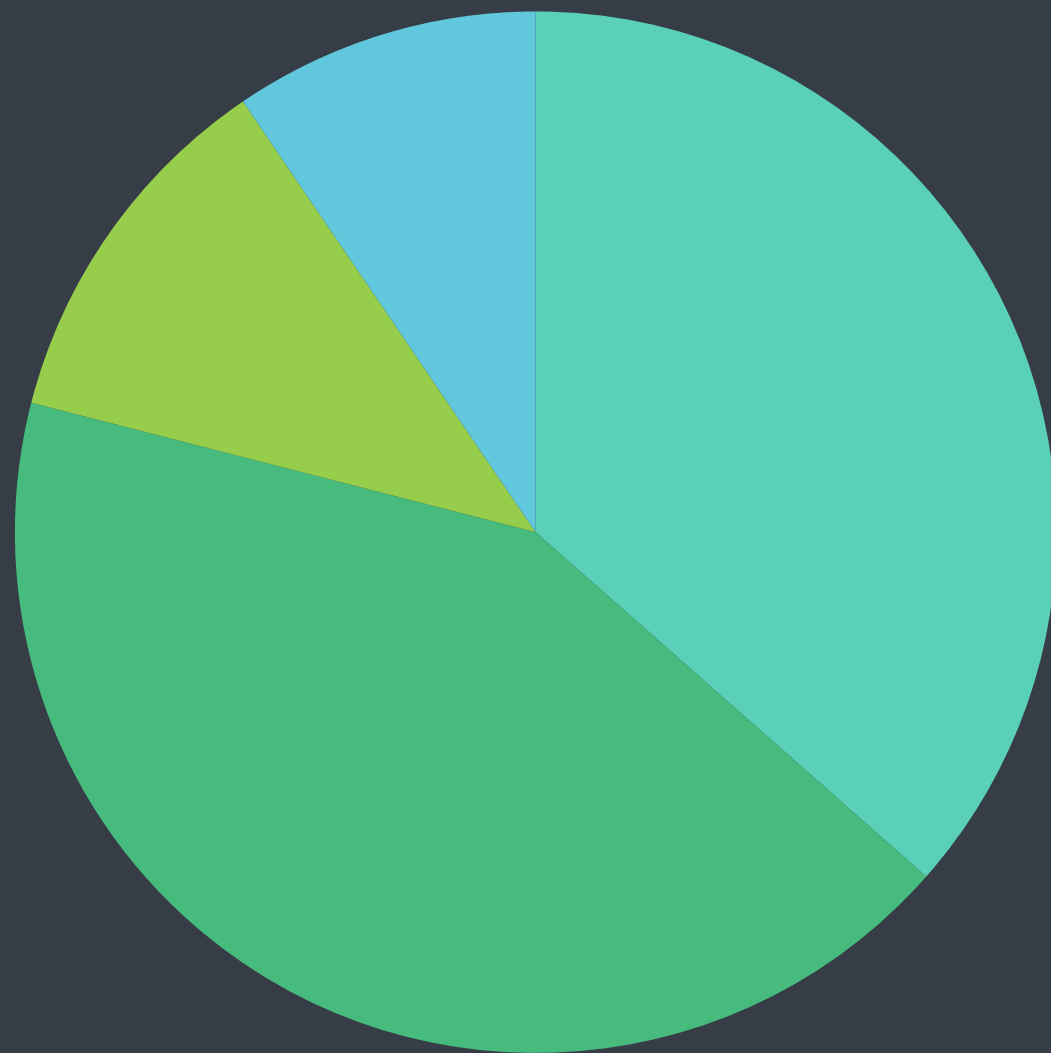


RACIAL EQUITY POLICY



- PASSED IN MAY 2018
- AIMED AT IMPROVING EDUCATIONAL OUTCOMES FOR STUDENTS OF COLOR AND SHRINKING THE ACHIEVEMENT GAP.
- JCPS IS 1 OF ONLY 11 PUBLIC SCHOOL DISTRICT IN THE COUNTRY TO PASS SUCH A POLICY

- NEED FOR THE POLICY:
 - WIDENING ACHIEVEMENT GAP
 - DISPROPORTIONALITY IN SUSPENSIONS AND REFERRALS FOR ADVANCE PLACEMENT, DUAL CREDIT, GIFTED AND TALENTED PROGRAMS
 - DEMOGRAPHIC SHIFTS — OVER HALF OF JCPS STUDENTS ARE STUDENTS OF COLOR
