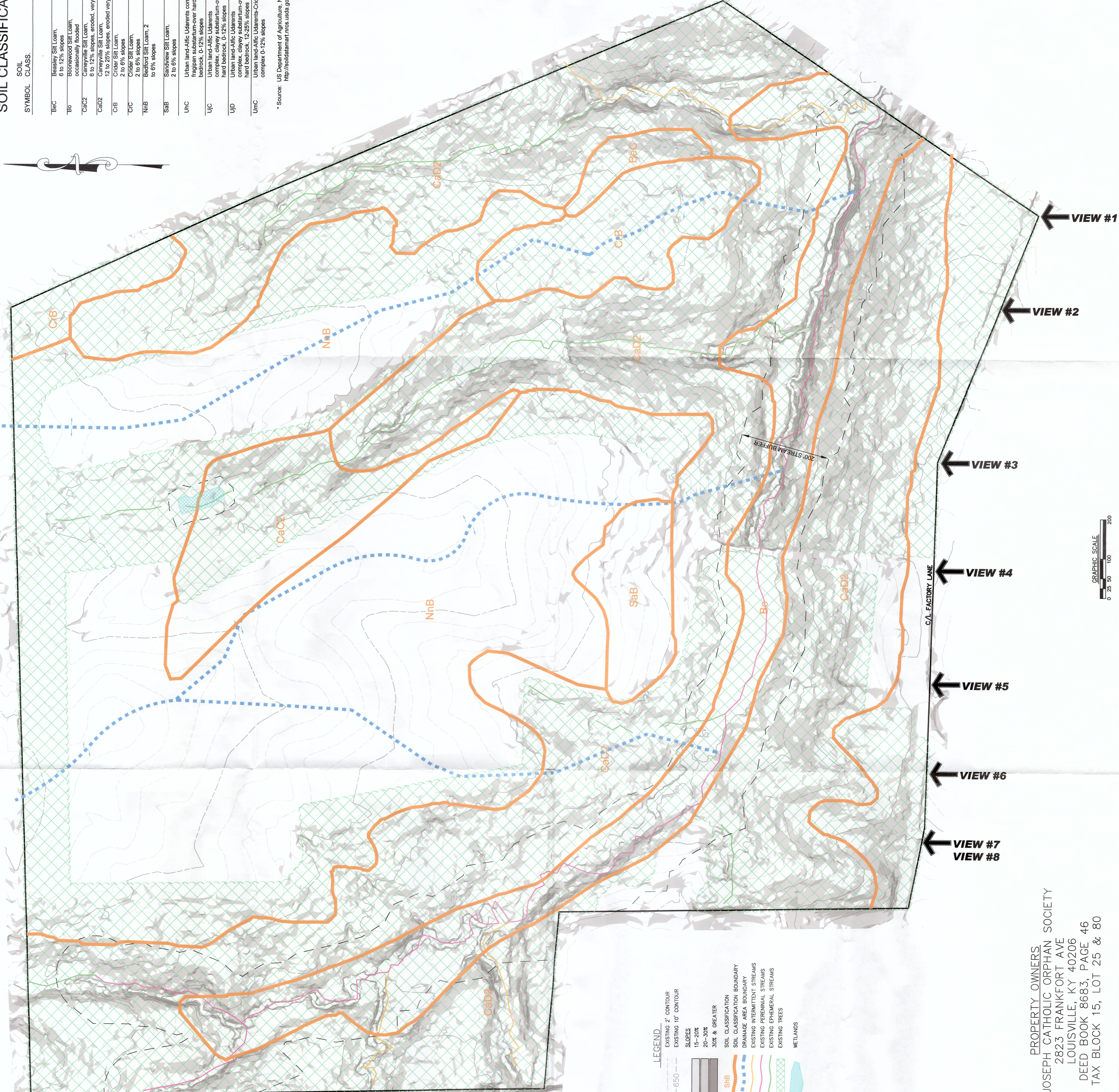

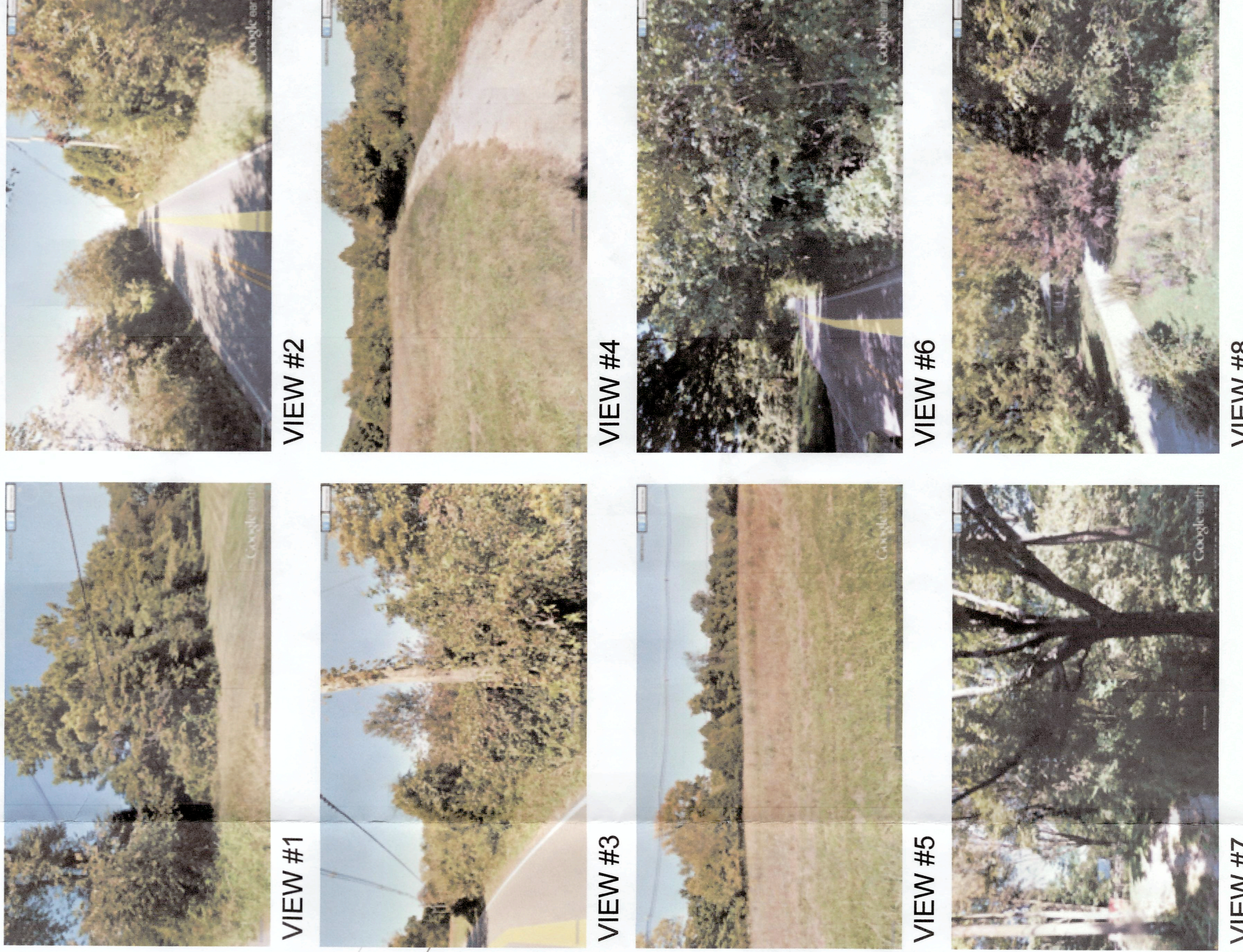

**VIEW SHED ANALYSIS**

OVERGROW AND INVASIVE VEGETATION PREVENTS VIEWS INTO THE PROPERTY. AS A PART OF DEVELOPMENT, EXISTING VEGETATION WILL BE REMOVED AND REPLACED WITH SCREENING VEGETATION IN ORDER TO MAINTAIN SCREENED VIEWS INTO THE SITE. EXISTING OVERHEAD POWERLINES WILL PREVENT THE PLANTING OF LARGE TREES ADJACENT TO THE ROADWAY.



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
