>>>>> We have obtained a cost estimate for the truck warning sign flashers on Dixie Hwy at LG&E and CEMEX. The cost for 48" LED truck warnings signs is \$2,105 each. Currently, there are (4) truck warning signs. If you would like to replace all of the existing signs the cost would be \$8,420. Because the (2) zones are relatively close together, we could only install flashers on the assembly entering each side of the zone. This cost will be \$4,210. We will need your approval and funding allocation before being able to move forward with the purchase of the signs. Please let me know if or which of these options you are in favor of and we will work with KYTC to obtain the permit.
