I am sending this budget and letter for the 2019 Back to School Festival, scheduled for August 11, 2019, to the other Council members now.

The Annual First Neighborhood Place Back to School Festival is schedule for Saturday, August 10, 2019 from 10:00 a.m. – 1:00 p.m. We anticipate providing 1,000 to 1,500 kids with backpacks and school supplies. We have serviced well over 15,000 kids over the past 13 years. Once again, we foresee 20 schools-elementary, middle and high-working together with us on this project. Last year we provided supplies to students who attend over 75 different schools. Annually, this is one of the best attended and organized Back to School events in the city.
