As you know, Councilman Winkler appropriated funds a couple of months ago towards the purchase of two Cardinal Stadium benches. Working with Mitchell Stoops of TARC, we have found two stops that would be good fits for these benches. The only caveat is they both are probably going to need concrete pads as the sidewalk is not deep enough otherwise. Would you mind giving us an estimate on the installation of these two benches that includes concrete pads?

The first picture is of an eastbound stop near the intersection of Hurstbourne Parkway and Westport Road. This is a very busy intersection and a highly visible stop. The second picture is a westbound stop almost directly across the street.
