

Councilwoman Flood,

Please consider this letter as our official Statement of Cost for all speed hump related work. Each speed hump, including markings is \$2,050.00 and each sign is \$260.00. Based on our Engineering Studies, a total of three (3) speed humps and two (2) speed hump signs have been proposed for Woodpointe Blvd., between South Park Road and Bonaventure Blvd. The total "not to exceed" cost is \$6,670.00.

As I understand it, you and your office will fund half the amount which totals **\$3,335.00** and the HOA at Woodfield Commons has agreed to fund the remaining half, which totals \$3,335.00.

Upon funding approval, the speed humps will be installed as schedule and weather permits.
