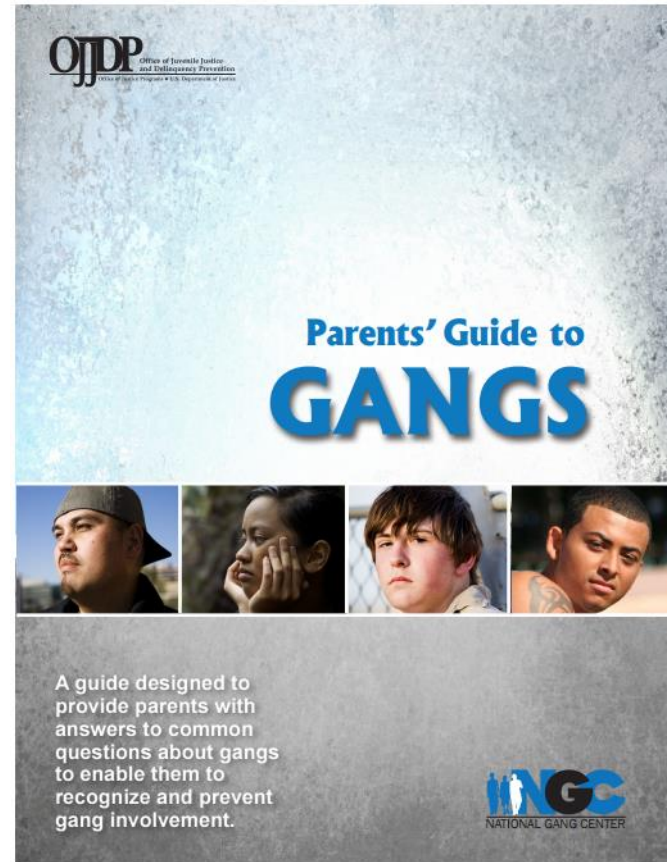

WHAT ARE THE CONSEQUENCES OF GANG INVOLVEMENT?

More likely to commit crimes

More likely to be arrested

Less likely to graduate high school

Less likely to maintain employment

More likely to develop health problems



HOW DO I KNOW IF MY CHILD IS INVOLVED IN A GANG

Risk Factors

12-14 years old – high risk

15 years old – most likely to join

Males more involved than females

Females face exploitation

Changes in behavior
