

ORDINANCE NO. 155, SERIES 2016

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$20,000 FROM THE NEIGHBORHOOD DEVELOPMENT FUNDS OF DISTRICTS 8 AND 9, THROUGH THE OFFICE OF MANAGEMENT AND BUDGET, TO THE HIGHLAND COMMERCE GUILD, INC., FOR GRAFFITI REMOVAL AND ABATEMENT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE LOUISVILLE/JEFFERSON COUNTY METRO GOVERNMENT (THE COUNCIL) AS FOLLOWS:


SECTION I: The sum of \$20,000 is hereby appropriated from the Neighborhood Development Funds of Districts 8 and 9, through the Office of Management and Budget, to the Highland Commerce Guild, Inc., for graffiti removal and abatement program in Districts 8 and 9. District 8 appropriates \$15,000 and District 9 appropriates \$5,000.


SECTION II: The Council has determined that the funds requested in this Ordinance shall be expended for a public purpose.
