May $4-14^{th} + 13-16^{th}$

Brief Overview:

- Two days in Moscow
 - Meeting at the US Embassy
 - Visit St. Basil and the Kremlin
- Six Days in Perm
 - 75th Anniversary of VE Day
 - Meetings with Perm City Council, businesses, and schools
 - Collaborative performances by musicians from Louisville & Perm
 - Some tourism visits to cultural historic sites
- Three days in Saint Petersburg (Optional)
 - Visit museums including the Hermitage,
 Catherine Palace & Peterhof Palace





May $4-14^{th} + 13-16^{th}$

Trip includes:

- All accommodation
- All transportation
- Most dinners and breakfasts
- Excursion & Museum entrance fees
- Participation in 75th VE Day Anniversary festivities

Travel Dates in May:

4: Leave Louisville

5: Arrive in Moscow

6: Leave Moscow, Arrive in Perm

6-13: Perm

14: Arrive in Louisville

13-16: Saint Petersburg (Optional)



Trip Cost:

$3,919 – standard (full fare per person, double occupancy)
```

- + \$1,739 optional trip to Saint Petersburg
- + \$ 239 single occupancy in Perm hotel
- +\$ 379 single occupancy in Saint Petersburg hotel

However, we have applied for a grant from the US Embassy Moscow to cover about 2/3 the cost of the standard trip.
