

Total = \$7,340.00

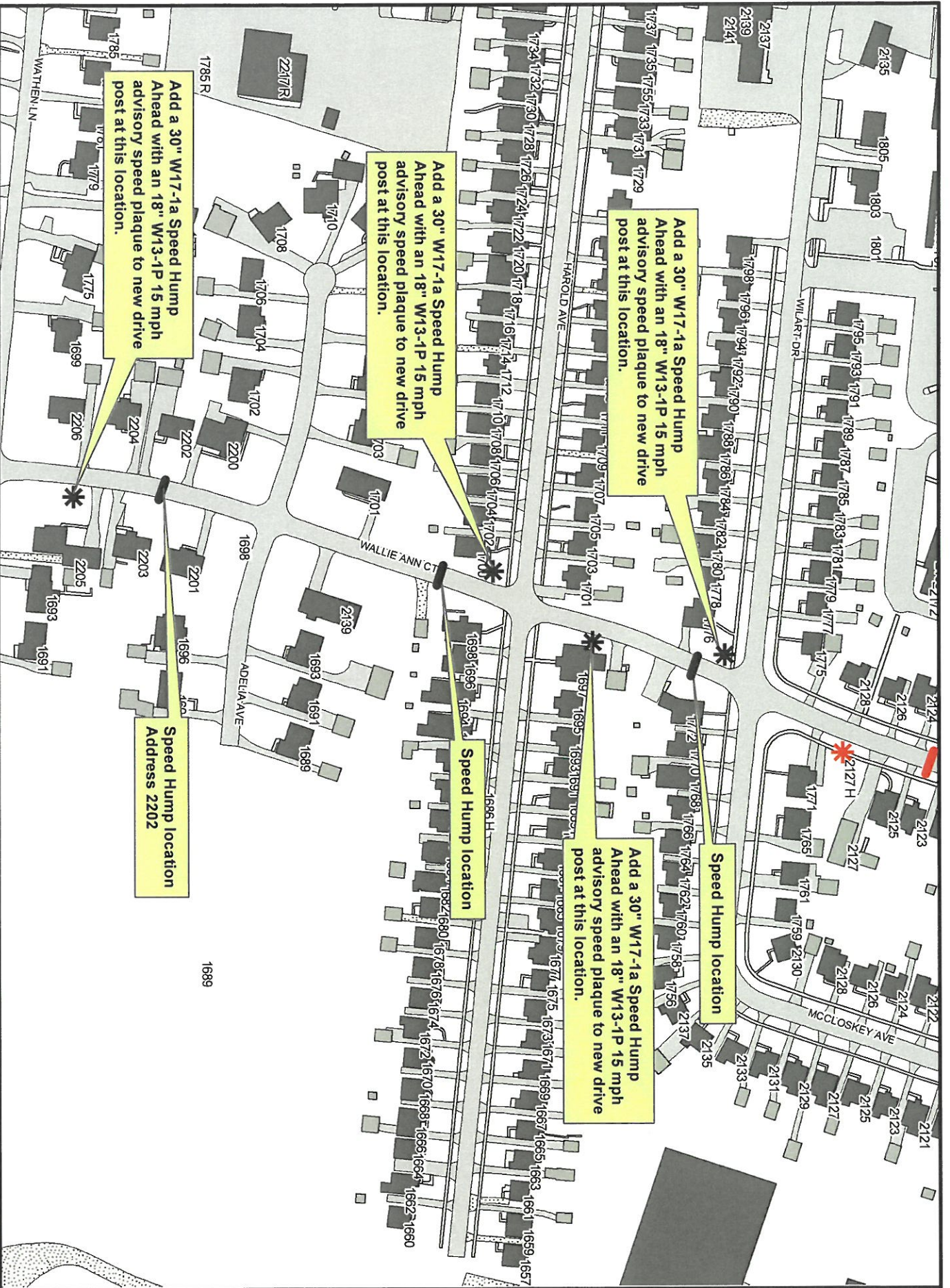

The total "not to exceed" cost is \$7,340.00.
