A RESOLUTION INITIATING A REVIEW OF THE DECISION OF THE LANDMARKS COMMISSION DESIGNATING THE PROPERTY LOCATED AT 211-215 WEST MUHAMMAD ALI BOULEVARD IN LOUISVILLE METRO AS A LOCAL LANDMARK.

WHEREAS, the Landmarks Commission held a public hearing on November 19, 2020 on a petition to designate the property at 211-215 West Muhammad Ali Boulevard in Louisville Metro as a local landmark (20-LANDMARK-0001), and the Commission on November 19, 2020 by a vote of 10 For, 2 Opposed, 1 Abstain and approved that designation; and


WHEREAS, the Legislative Council of the Louisville/Jefferson County Metro Government ("Council") has the power and authority under Section 32.260(Q) of the Landmarks Ordinance to review and uphold, modify, or overturn that designation; and

WHEREAS, the Council finds such a review is warranted.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE LOUISVILLE/JEFFERSON COUNTY METRO GOVERNMENT AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I: The Council hereby initiates a review of the November 19, 2020 decision of the Landmarks Commission designating the property at 211-215 West Muhammad Ali Boulevard in Louisville Metro as a local landmark. The review of the information presented to the Landmarks Commission will be held by the Planning and Zoning Committee which will set the date of the review.


SECTION II: This Resolution shall take effect upon its passage and approval.
