- Just like we had to do at 4<sup>th</sup> & Industry CSX railroad underpass requires us to have the CSX inspector monitor work and drilling into the RR underpass. The cost for this inspector on site is included as a line Item breakout in the attached quote.
- Quotation also includes a line item to close road to replace the roadway fixtures. After looking at the road and driving it, the fixtures are right over the center lane. There is not enough rom to push traffic to other side and make a safe work zone for the crews. All DMS, cones, detour signs, barricades are included in this pricing.
