

**ORDINANCE NO. \_\_\_\_\_, SERIES 2019**

**AN ORDINANCE CLOSING A 1.467 ACRE SECTION OF TURKEY RUN PARKWAY ON THE PROPERTY OF THE FUTURE FUND, INC. AND BEING IN LOUISVILLE METRO (CASE NO. 18STREETS1026).**

**SPONSORED BY: COUNCILWOMAN MADONNA FLOOD**

**WHEREAS**, the Louisville Metro Planning Commission, as set forth in its minutes and records of Case No. 18STREETS1026, has recommended to the Legislative Council of the Louisville/Jefferson County Metro Government (the "Council") that a 1.467 acre section of Turkey Run Parkway on the property of The Future Fund, Inc. and being in Louisville Metro be closed because it complies with the goals, objectives and plan elements of the Comprehensive Plan; and

**WHEREAS**, the Council concurs in and adopts the findings of the Planning Commission in Case No. 18STREETS1026 and approves and accepts the recommendation of the Planning Commission as set out in said minutes and records.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE LOUISVILLE/JEFFERSON COUNTY METRO GOVERNMENT AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION I:** That a 1.467 acre section of Turkey Run Parkway on the property of The Future Fund, Inc. and being in Louisville Metro, as more particularly described in the minutes and records of the Planning Commission in Case No. 18STREETS1026 and as shown on the attached right-of-way closing plat, be closed subject to all existing easements of record and all existing utility easements or rights enjoyed by said utility companies as the result of being located in, on or over said right-of-way.

**SECTION II:** This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and approval.
