ORDINANCE NO. 147, SERIES 2021

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$5,000 \$7,500 \$8,000 FROM DISTRICT 22 NEIGHBORHOOD DEVELOPMENT FUNDS IN THE FOLLOWING MANNER: \$5,000 FROM DISTRICT 22; \$2,000 FROM DISTRICT 21; \$500 FROM DISTRICT 2; AND \$250 EACH FROM DISTRICTS 17 AND 25; THROUGH THE OFFICE OF MANAGEMENT AND BUDGET, TO C.H.O.I.C.E. INC. TO ASSIST WITH FUNDING FOR THE "DARE TO DREAM" SPORTS LEADERSHIP AND MENTORING PROGRAM FOR THE 2021-2022 SCHOOL YEAR (AS AMENDED).

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE LOUISVILLE/JEFFERSON COUNTY METRO GOVERNMENT ("THE COUNCIL") AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I: The sum of \$5,000 \$7,500 is hereby appropriated from District 22 Neighborhood Development Funds in the following manner: \$5,000 from District 22; \$2,000 from District 21; \$500 from District 2; and \$250 each from Districts 17 and 25; through the Office of Management and Budget, to C.H.O.I.C.E. Inc. to assist with funding for the "Dare to Dream" Sports Leadership and Mentoring Program for the 2021-2022 school year.

SECTION II: The Council has determined the funds requested in this Ordinance will be expended for a public purpose.

SECTION III: This grant is subject to the Council's Policies and Procedures as adopted and effective at the date of passage of this Ordinance.

SECTION IV: This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and approval.
