To contract and be contracted with; to sue and be sued; to establish, alter and enforce rules and regulations in furtherance of the purpose of the transit authority's creation; acquire real or personal property, easements, franchises, bus certificates, or other rights by any lawful means necessary to its operation of any existing mass transit system (incl. through the power of eminent domain); may issue revenue bonds, and general obligation bonds; provide for insurance of its properties, for workers compensation, for public liability or any other risk or hazard arising from its activities; may conduct such studies and surveys, gather such information, and institute such programs and plans as may be reasonable necessary to carry out the purpose of the transit authority .

KRS 96A.070(9).

An annual audit of the transit authority's accounts and affairs shall be made and a report thereof shall also be made; file an annual budget of current expenses and an annual report to the Board of Aldermen for revision, amendment, approval or disapproval.

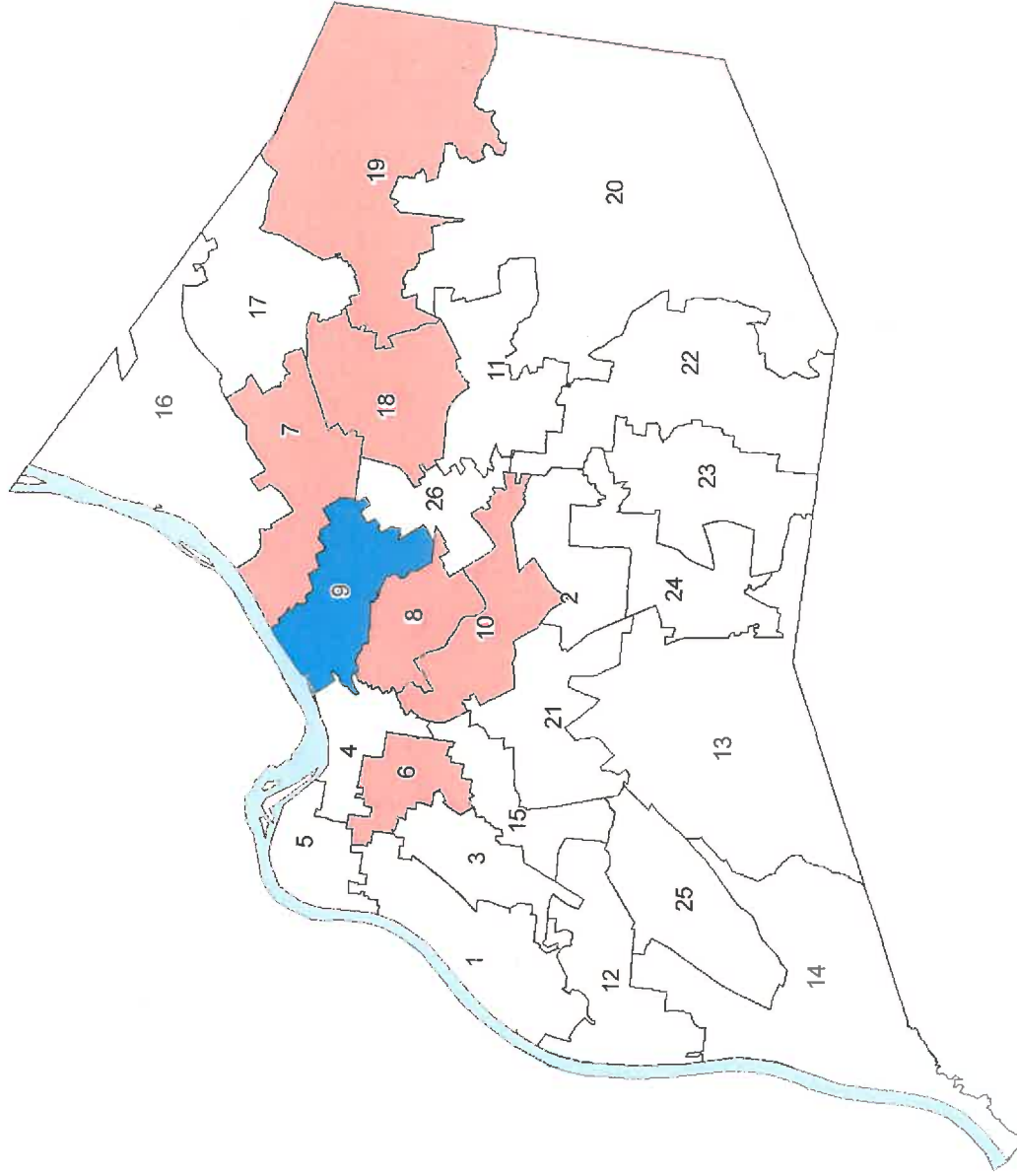
