Erin, I'm proposing a different connection based on your email, and based on our conversation this morning. Let's cross-over to the east side of Stony Brook and Six Mile, onto Galene. And then cross the RR tracks on the east side, and connect to the existing sidewalks that lead up to Hurstbourne Pkwy. Let's still make the short connection on Galene Dr. Please see map attached for all.

A <u>rough estimate</u> for this would be \$40,000.00 which includes sidewalks, ramps, striping, drainage, surveying & engineering to confirm right of way, and contingencies for anything unforeseen.

I'm not sure what kind of approvals we'd have to get from the RR for crossing their tracks, but I'll find out. Also, I noticed that maintenance responsibilities along Stony Brook north of the Tracks-north of Six Mile belong to "Suburban Cities", so there would be some coordination needed prior to design & construction.

(also, if you want to make the connection on the west side from Six Mile to Lantern Lite Pkwy, add on \$30,000.00)
